Some of you may remember that in Lent we traditionally hosted Soup lunches. These were originally developed in Churches to raise funds for charity as part of our Lenten journey. In Lent we are encouraged to 'fast on certain days' or 'give up' certain things. The Soup lunch was intended to be a simple lunch of soup, bread and cheese. Those attending would then be invited to make a donation – of the money they would have spent on the things they had given up or saved spending on a meal.

We will be re-introducing a simple soup lunch this Lent to recapture something of that original concept. We hope you might join us as we meet and help support the
