# Watch and Pray in Holy Week



At the heart of our community of faith is the journey to the Cross and then the empty tomb of Easter Day. Jesus invites his friends and disciples to 'watch and pray' with him as he prepares for that journey. We are encouraged to simply be with him through those days and create the time and space to be stand at the foot off the cross and gather at the tomb.

Each year we are invited to share that journey and reflect on what it means for us, as we share in the special service of Holy Week and Easter. Some will be aware how special and important the services are; for others it will be a new experience, and for some it will be something we need to re-engage with.

Perhaps we could all make that extra effort and commit ourselves to walk together from the joy of the Palm Procession to the discovery of the Risen Christ on Easter Day We will be welcoming a guest preacher to help us reflect on this journey. On Monday Tuesday and Wednesday evening at 7pm there will be a Mass with hymns at St Mary's – at the end of which Revd Amanda Collinson (the Bishop's Chaplain) will reflect with us on the people who watch and pray at the Cross.

At **St Mary's** from Maundy Thursday to Easter Day **Fr Bob will be our preacher** and help us to reflect on the events we are sharing in and how they affect our lives today. St Faith's will have their own pattern for Maundy Thursday and Good Friday – and then we will be together to celebrate the Easter Vigil on Holy Saturday together at St Mary's at 8.30pm.
