It was announced at the PCC that the Diocese will be funding a **Choir Church project** in the Parish. This will fund Brian Moles to provide an after school choir club at Penbridge and Arundel Court weekly and to lead to a service of celebration once a term in the Church. The PCC agreed to appoint **Revd Julie Jackson** (who will be a Half time post at St Luke's) to also work with us for one day a

week to support the clubs with a faith input and to support our Messy Church team.

We are delighted to welcome Julie back as she did her placement with us a few years ago before ordination. Her work will be part funded by the Diocese and part funded by the Swishers legacy fund that we hold. We are so grateful to the two schools for their support in this.

The project will start in September.
