We sit for the Sermon

After the sermon those to be baptised, confirmed or affirming their faith gather at the Dais with their sponsors. The Bishop asks the candidate for baptism:

Nevaeh do you wish to be baptised?

Nevaeh I do

The Bishop asks the candidates for confirmation

Have you been baptized in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit?

Candidates I have.

The Bishop asks all the candidates

Are you ready with your own mouth and from your own heart to affirm your faith in Jesus Christ?

Candidates I am

The Bishop addresses the whole congregation

Faith is the gift of God to his people.

In baptism the Lord is adding to our number those whom he is calling. People of God, will you welcome these candidates and uphold them

in their life in Christ

All With the help of God, we will.

The Bishop speaks to the candidates

In baptism, God calls us out of darkness into his marvellous light. To follow Christ means dying to sin and rising to new life with him.

Therefore I ask these questions:

Do you turn to Christ?

Candidates I turn to Christ.

Do you repent of your sins?

Candidates I repent of my sins.

Do you renounce evil?

Candidates I renounce evil.

The Bishop makes the sign of the cross on the forehead of Nevaeh saying Christ claims you for his own.

Receive the sign of his cross.

The Bishop then says

Do not be ashamed to confess the faith of Christ crucified.

All Fight valiantly as a disciple of Christ against sin, the world and the devil, and remain faithful to Christ to the end of your life.

May almighty God deliver you from the powers of darkness, restore in you the image of his glory, and lead you in the light and obedience of Christ.

All Amen.

We all sing

As the Bishop, Clergy and Candidates together with their sponsors process to the Font.

Now is eternal life, if risen with Christ we stand, in him to life reborn, and, held within his hand; no more we fear death's ancient dread, in Christ arisen from the dead!

For God, the living God, stooped down to share our state; by death destroying death, Christ opened wide life's gate. He lives, who died; he reigns on high; who lives in him shall never die.

Brothers and sisters, I ask you to profess together with these candidates the faith of the Church Do you believe and trust in God the Father source of all being and life, the one for whom we exist?

We believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Son,

who took our human nature, died for us

and rose again?

We believe and trust in him.

Do you believe and trust in God the Holy Spirit, who gives life to the people of God and makes Christ known in the world?

We believe and trust in him.

This is the faith of the Church.

We believe and trust in one God, Father, Son and Holy Spirit.

The Bishop addresses Nevaeh

Nevaeh is this your faith?

Nevaeh This is my faith.

The Bishop pours water on her, saying

I baptize you in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit.

All Amen.

May God, who has received you by baptism into his Church, pour upon you the riches of his grace, that within the company of Christ's pilgrim people you may daily be renewed by his anointing Spirit, and come to the inheritance of the saints in glory.

Declaration for Affirmation

Val stands before the bishop, who says

I call upon Val who wishes to affirm her baptismal faith to renew her commitment to Jesus Christ.

Val faces the people and make this declaration

I answer the call of God my creator.

I trust in Jesus Christ as my Saviour.

I seek new life from the Holy Spirit.

The congregation responds

All God, who has called you, is faithful.

Rejoice in your baptism into Jesus Christ.

Walk with us in the life of the Spirit.

Declaration for Reception

Giulia who is to be received into the communion of the Church of England stands before the bishop to make this declaration. The bishop says

You are here to be received into the communion of the Church of England.

Do you acknowledge the Church of England as part of the one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church

Giulia I do.

Do you accept the teaching, discipline and authority of the Church of England?

Giulia I do.

Will you take part with us in worship and mission?

Giulia I will.

Bishop Almighty God,

we thank you for our fellowship

in the household of faith

with all who have been baptized into your name.

Keep us faithful to our baptism,

and so make us ready for that day

when the whole creation shall be made perfect

in your Son, our Saviour Jesus Christ.

All Amen.

The candidates come forward to the font and sign themselves with water. All the candidates then process with the clergy to the front of the Church.

We all sing

Take, O take me as I am, Summon out what I shall be, Set your seal upon my heart and live in me.

The Confirmation

The Bishop stands before those who are to be confirmed, and says:

Our help is in the name of the Lord who has made heaven and earth.

Blessed be the name of the Lord now and for ever. Amen.

The Bishop extends his hands towards those to be confirmed and says:

Almighty and ever-living God, you have given these your servants new birth in baptism by water and the Spirit, and have forgiven them all their sins.

Let your Holy Spirit rest upon them: the Spirit of wisdom and understanding; the Spirit of counsel and inward strength; the Spirit of knowledge and true godliness; and let their delight be in the fear of the Lord. Amen.

Each candidate is presented by their sponsor. The Bishop addresses each candidate by name as he anoints them with the Oil of Chrism.

N, God has called you by name and made you his own. He then lays his hand on the head of each, saying:

Confirm, O Lord, your servant with your Holy Spirit **Amen.** The bishop extends his hands towards Val and says:

God of mercy and love, in baptism you welcome the sinner and restore the dead to life. You create a clean heart in those who repent, and give your Holy Spirit to those who ask. Grant that these your servants may grow into the fullness of the stature of Christ. Equip them with the gifts of your Holy Spirit, and fill them with faith in Jesus Christ

and with love for all your people, in the service of your kingdom. **Amen.**

The bishop lays his hand on her, saying:

Val may God renew his life within you that you may confess his name this day and for ever.

All Amen.

The bishop extends his hands towards Giulia to be received and says: God of mercy and love,

by one Spirit we have all been baptized into one body and made to drink of the one Spirit; we thank you for the gifts you have given to this your servant, Giulia for the building up of the body of Christ.

Grant that she may continue in the life of the Spirit and walk with us in the light and obedience of Christ. By the same Spirit, fill the whole Church with your overflowing love; give us knowledge and discernment of your will, and steadfastness in your service, until we all come to the unity of the faith, to the measure of the full stature of Christ, through whom we make our prayer.

All Amen.

The bishop takes Giulia's hand, saying:

Giulia, we recognise you as a member of the one, holy, catholic and apostolic Church; and we receive you into the communion of the Church of England in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit

All Amen.

The Bishop invites the congregation to pray for all the candidates:

Defend, O Lord, these your servants with your heavenly grace, that they may continue yours for ever, and daily increase in your Holy Spirit more and more until they come to your everlasting kingdom. Amen.

We share Christ's love and peace

After the introduction

Communion

As communion is distributed, wherever you are, pray that you may be aware of Christ's presence with you and that you will be blessed and comforted by it. If you are at Church, please come forward to the Dais to receive standing, if you wish to receive at your seat please stand at the end of distribution. During Communion the Choir will sing an anthem, after which we all sing

Lord Jesus Christ, you have come to us, you are one with us, Mary's son; cleansing our souls from all their sin, pouring your love and goodness in; Jesus, our love for you we sing, living Lord. Lord Jesus Christ,
now and every day
teach us how to pray,

The clergy give each candidate a lighted candle. These are lit from the Paschal candle.

Bishop God has delivered us from the dominion of darkness and has given us a place with the saints in light.

You have received the light of Christ; walk in this light all the days of your life.

All Shine as a light in the world to the glory of God the Father.

We are blessed

The Lord be with you and also with you.

The Bishop gives God's Blessing and all respond **Amen.**

Go in the light and peace of Christ. Thanks be to God.
