

Stír Up, O Lord





In the Book of Common Prayer the Collect (Prayer at start of service) for the Last Sunday before Advent begins with the words '**Stir up, O Lord**,' and prays that we may 'bring forth the fruits of righteousness' in our lives.

Traditionally, this has become known as Stir Up Sunday and is the day to stir the Christmas Pudding mix and the

fruit it contains.

This Sunday (Nov 23rd) we come to the end of the Church's liturgical year as we celebrate Christ the King and start to turn towards Advent and our celebrations of Christmas.



You are invited this week to stir up your thoughts and reflect on your life of prayer and how you will be preparing to welcome Christ into our hearts and lives at Christmas, Next

Sunday (Nov 30th) we start the season of Advent and there are a variety of opportunities for you to give some time and space to God and your preparations for Christmas and the birth of Jesus, So as you stir up your hearts think about which of these can help you in that preparing to live fruitful lives.



This year we will be using the material from the Church of England which will focus on **the Advent Antiphons**. The Antiphons are the traditional sentences used before and after the Magnificat at Evening Prayer on the last 7 days of Advent. They each day begin 'O come, O come' and then focus on a different aspect of the coming Christ.



There is a book (if you want a copy let us know – but it is £9!) called 'O Come Emmanuel' which uses a daily reflection and artwork to consider the 7 antiphons. There are also new choral settings of the antiphons that have been written – you can listen to them here St Martin's Voices & Andrew Earis - The Advent Antiphons. You can also follow the reflections on the 'Every Day Faith

App' and we will be sharing some each day on social media.



Try and create time each day to pause, reflect and prepare for Christ's coming – perhaps if you have an advent Candle use that to focus your thinking and prayer each day.

There will also be a chance to join others each week to reflect on the material. We will be using the book for our conversations at Fellowship lunch on Wednesdays at St Mary's – after Noon service – bring you own lunch (Ist Group on Nov 26th)

At Breakfasts on Saturdays at 9am at St Mary's – please let Fr Bob know if you are joining us for catering purposes. On Saturday 6th and 13th December.

If you would like to meet with others at another time let one of the Ministry Team know and we will try to set something up.



You can mark the beginning of Advent by sharing in the Advent Service of Music and Readings led by the Choir, A beautiful service which marks the coming of light into the darkness. This will be at 6pm on Sunday Nov 30th.

On **Monday Dec 8**th there will also be a chance to be still and reflect at the **Julian Pryaer Group at St Faith's at 7.30pm**

You could also make a commitment to give some time to God through Advent by coming to the Sunday Services each week at 10am, or by sharing in one of the midweek services,

Whatever you do we hope you are able to stir up your souls and in the midst of everything else give time to being with God.



December is always a difficult month to get the right balance between joining in the build up to Christmas with Carols and celebrations and waiting for Christmas to come.
