**Pride in Place** As you may be aware the Government has set up a grant for £20million over 10 years to be used to improve the quality-of-life etc of Fratton West/Landport. This is an area approx. from Fratton Bridge to Lake Road – west side; Lake Road to Commercial Road – south side; back of Commercial Road – East side – to Railway line and back to Fratton Bridge.
