#### CARD 3

(Yes, with early diagnosis and treatment, leprosy can be cured.)

# Is the leprosy of the Bible the same leprosy we know today?

(Sometimes. The word leprosy in the Bible was likely used to describe a variety of other skin diseases as well as the disease we know as leprosy today.)

#### By what name is leprosy known today?

(Hansen's disease—named after the man who discovered the bacterium that causes the disease.)
