Verify Rubber Gasket Is Pre-installed on Tub



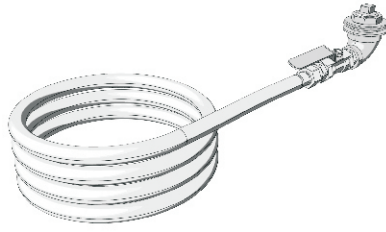

Note because of its shape it is visible from the top & bottom.

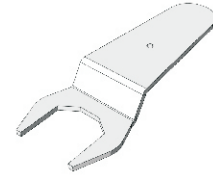

Choose Drain Fittings

! Make sure your hose faces the direction shown below.



★ Tip: Apply soap to get fitting through washer



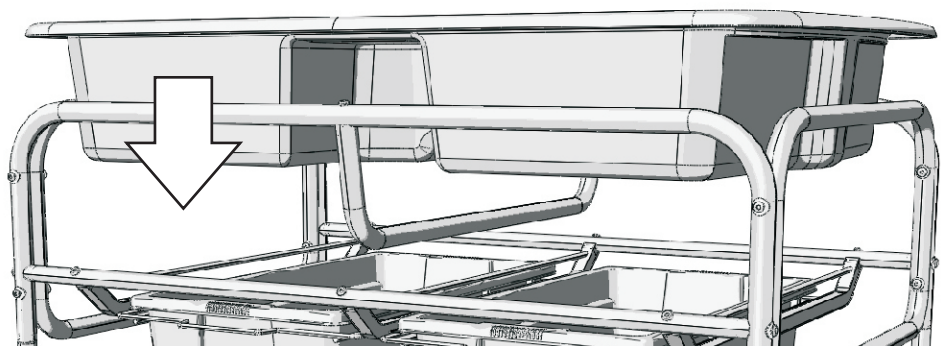
! Use the plug to keep sand out of drain.

! Use as backup only with water in case valve is accidentally opened.

Firmly tighten your fitting !

Tub drops into place for easy assembly

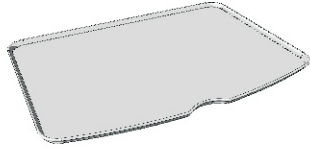
! Note your tub may rock from side to side at first when empty. Filling with sand / water will help it fit better.

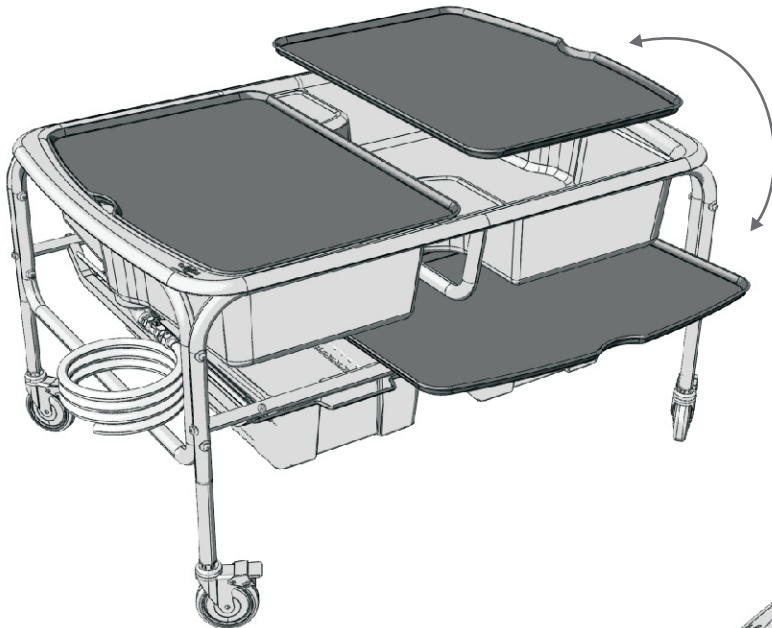
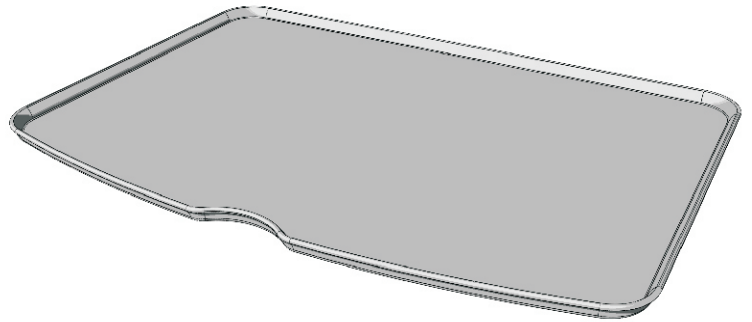

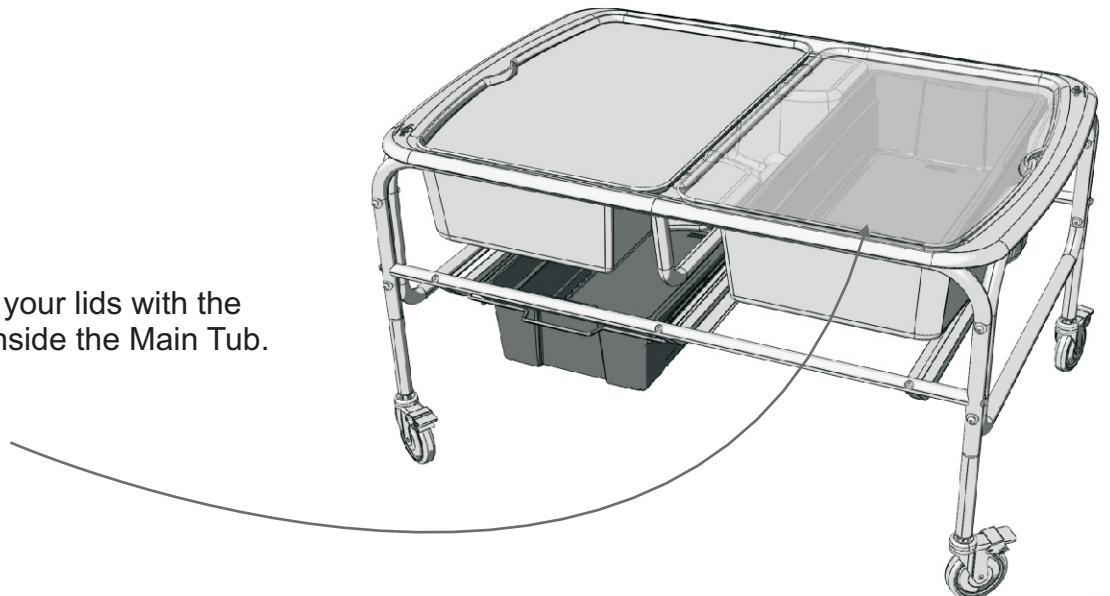
Using Your Lids

★ You can store your Lids under the Main Tub like shown on the left. Use one lid as a shelf for other activities.

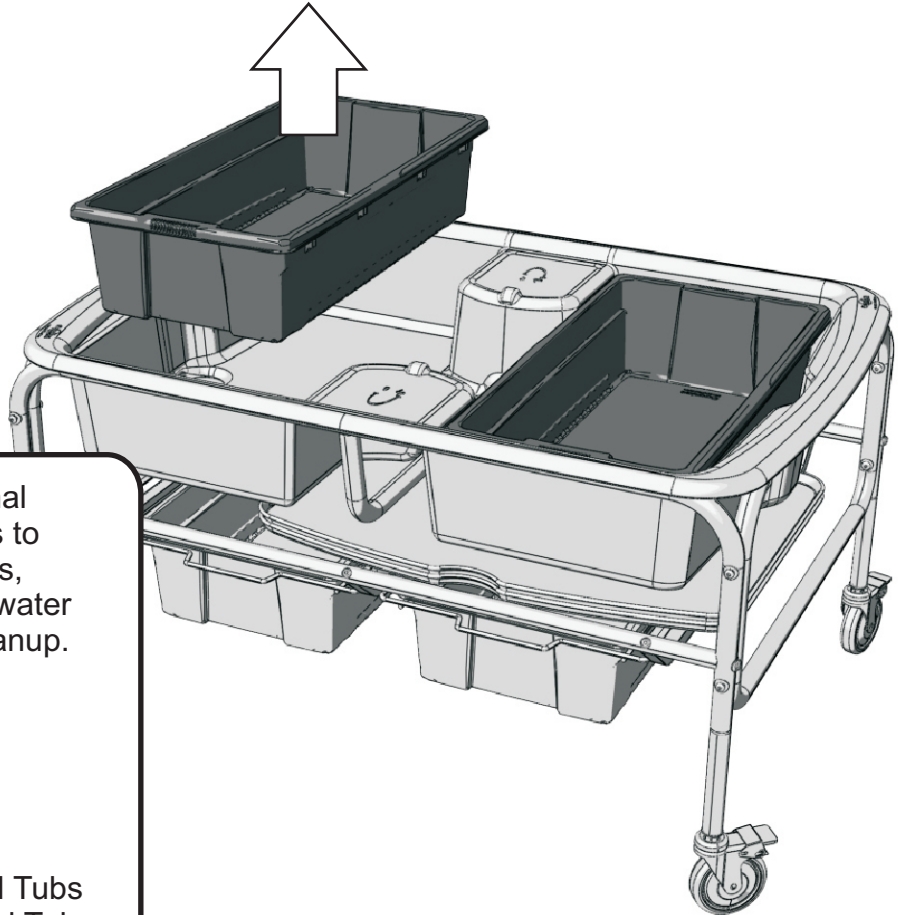
★ You can also use your lids with the Really Big Tubs inside the Main Tub.



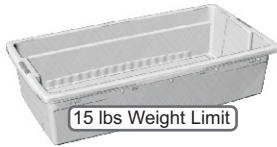

★ Use Tubs to store sand & water toys.



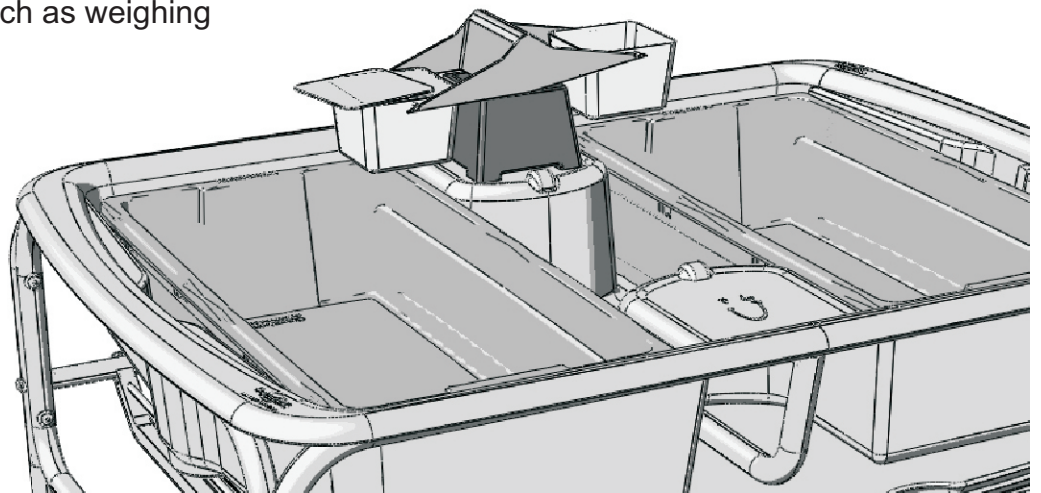
You can purchase additional Copernicus Really Big Tubs to separate different mediums, for example using sand AND water at the same time for easy cleanup.
