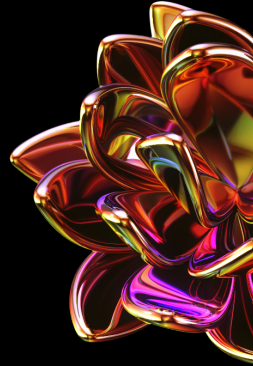

BAY AREA:

- [APENEJ](#): Asian Pacific Environmental Network: Part of the Oakland Chinatown Coalition and currently leading the on-the-ground organizing force in Oakland.
- [Oakland Vietnamese Community Center \(VACCEB\)](#): Delivers 30k meals/month for 2.5k clients, mostly elders.
- [Asian Prisoner Support Committee](#): Dedicated to supporting API prisoners and deportees.

- [Asian Law Caucus](#): Focuses on housing rights, immigration, civil rights, and labor issues.

- **CCED LA**: Builds grassroots power with low-income and immigrant communities through organizing, education, and mutual help in LA Chinatown.
- **SEACA LA**: Works with Southeast Asian youth and their communities on leadership dev, education, advocacy, and community organizing.
- **Little Tokyo Service Center**: Provides a comprehensive array of services to help low-income folks and others in need, while contributing to community revitalization and cultural preservation in Little Tokyo.
- **Center for The Pacific Asian Family**: Supports API immigrant survivors of domestic and sexual assault in times of crisis.

NEW YORK:

- **CAAAV**: Building grassroots power across low-income Asian immigrant and refugee communities in NYC.
- **Mekong NYC**: Aims to improve the quality of life of the Southeast Asian community in the Bronx and throughout NYC.
- **Womankind**: Works with survivors of gender-based violence, with an emphasis on helping Asian communities find refuge, recovery, and renewal.
- **Garden of Hope**: Dedicated to serving and rebuilding the lives of people who have been exposed to domestic violence, sexual assault, and human trafficking; specifically targeting its services towards Chinese communities in the NYC region.
- **Asian American Legal Defense & Education Fund**: National organization founded in 1974 that protects and promotes the civil rights of Asian Americans.
- **Museum of Chinese in America**: Celebrates the living history of the Chinese experience in America.
- **Welcome to Chinatown** – A grassroots initiative to support businesses and amplify voices to preserve NYC's beloved and historic Chinatown community.
- **Send Chinatown Love** – Helping small NYC Chinatown business owners in need through donations and business development support.
- **Heart of Dinner** – Donate to deliver a meal to Asian elders across NYC.
