



Privacy Policy



The following Privacy Policy constitute a legally binding agreement made between You, whether personally or on behalf of an entity (“**You**”) and CNFT Predator (“**CNFT Predator**”, “**We**”, “**Us**”, or “**Our**”), concerning Your access (however accessed, whether via web, mobile, or otherwise) to and use of the cnftjungle.io website and all the other Sub-domains related to cnftjungle.io (“**Site**”).

Your Privacy is important to Us, therefore we comply with the applicable data protection laws, including the EU General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR) and Switzerland's Federal Act on Data Protection (FADP). BY USING OUR SITE OR OUR SERVICES, YOU CONSENT TO THE PRIVACY POLICY.

1. What information we collect from you

We collect Your Data through a variety of methods: either You provide it to Us directly, we collect it from external sources, or we collect it by using automated means.

1.1 Information You give Us

You may give Us information about You, such as Your name and contact information, language preference, job title, business affiliations and other information, by filling in forms on Our Sites or by corresponding with Us by discord, phone, email or otherwise. This includes information you provide when you report a problem.

We may collect Your Data If You register or login to Our Sites using social media (e.g., Discord, Google, or Twitter) to authenticate your identity and connect your social media login information with us. We may process geographical locations. We may also collect data through public sources.

By linking Your Wallet to Our Site we may collect Transaction information. We retain the right to collect from You Technical information, such as Your Cardano wallet address and network information regarding transactions. In connection to Our Services we may collect and maintain information relating to transactions you effect using Our Services.

1.2 Automatically collected Information

Following information might be automatically collected in order to enter the Site or use Our Services: Internet Protocol ("IP") address, date and time of the website call, time zone difference to GMT, content of the called website, operating system and access status / HTTP-status code, volume of transferred data, referrer-URL, information concerning the type, language and version of the internet browser used. We only use Your Data where we have a legal basis to do so.

1.3 Data form third parties

We may collect personal data from companies that offer their products and/or services for use in conjunction with our Service or whose products and/or services may be linked from our Service.

1.4 Public information Observed from the blockchain

We collect data from the public blockchain such as, but not limited to, addresses, NFT sales transfers purchases.

2. How We will use Your Data

We collect Your data to:

- Provide Our Services (including customer support)
- Personalize Your experience and improve the Service
- Verify your identity
- Process transactions
- Improve, develop and market our Services
- Investigate and address conduct that may violate our Terms of Service
- Detect, prevent, and address fraud, violations of our terms or policies, and/or other harmful or unlawful activity
- Analyze Our Services
- Resolve disputes, collect payments, troubleshoot problems
- Communicate with You about Our Services. We also use your Personal Data to respond to any questions, comments or requests you filed with us and the handling of any complaints
- Comply with legal obligations or regulatory requirements

3. Data Retention

We will only retain your personal information for as long as necessary to fulfil the purposes for which we collected it, including for the purposes of satisfying any legal, accounting, or reporting obligations or to resolve disputes. When Personal Data is no longer necessary for the purpose for which it was collected, We will remove any details that identifies You or We will securely destroy the records, where permissible.

4. Disclosure of Personal Data to third parties

We may share your information with selected recipients to perform functions required to provide certain Services to you and/or in connection with Our efforts to prevent and investigate fraudulent or other criminal activity. All such third parties will be contractually bound to protect data in compliance with our Privacy Policy:

- Service providers who help with Our business operations and to deliver Our Services, such as

Cloud service providers providing cloud infrastructure

- Law enforcement, government officials, regulatory agencies, Our banks, and other third parties pursuant to a subpoena, court order or other legal process; or when We believe, in Our sole discretion, that the disclosure of data is necessary to report suspected illegal or fraudulent activity or to investigate violations of Our Terms and Condition
- Funding and transaction information related to Your use of certain Services may be recorded on a public blockchain (Cardano). Public blockchains are distributed ledgers, intended to immutably record transactions across wide networks of computer systems. Many blockchains are open to forensic analysis which can lead to deanonymization and the unintentional revelation of private financial information, especially when block chain data is combined with other data. Because blockchains are decentralised are not controlled or operated by Us, We are not able to erase, modify, or alter Personal Data from such networks
- Our professional advisers including lawyers, auditors and insurers
- Marketing service Providers
- Third party service providers who help us with client insight analytics, such technical infrastructure and Service analysis
- Affiliates: We may share Your Personal Information with any subsidiaries, joint ventures, or other companies under our common control, in which case we will require our Affiliates to honor this Privacy Policy.

5. Third-Party Websites

Our Service may contain links to third-party websites. When You click on a link to any other website or location, You will leave our Service and go to another site, and another entity may collect Personal Data from you. We have no control over these third-party websites or their content. The terms of this Privacy Policy do not apply to these third-party websites or their content. links to third-party do not signify our endorsement of such third parties or their products, content, or websites.

6. Third-Party Wallets

To use some of our Services, you must use a third-party wallet which allows you to engage in transactions on public blockchains. Your interactions with any third-party wallet provider are governed by the applicable terms of service and privacy policy of that third party.

7. What are Your rights?

Under the GDPR You have rights related to Your Personal Data:

- Right to object. You have the right to object to processing of Your Personal Data where we are relying on legitimate interests as our legal basis. Under certain circumstances, We may

have compelling legitimate grounds that allow Us to continue processing your Personal Data

- You have the right to request access to Your Personal Data
- You have the Right to request rectification of the Personal Data We hold about You
- You have the right to request erasure of Your Personal Data
- You have the right to request restriction of processing of your Personal Data
- You have the right to data portability
- You have the right to be notified by rectification or erasure of Personal Data
- Right to submit a complaint with the supervisory authority
- Right to withdraw consent
