



The Non-resident Ambassador of Ukraine Presents his Credentials to the President

The Non-resident Ambassador of Ukraine, His Excellency Igor Polikha, presented his Letter of Credence to President Abdulla Yameen Abdul Gayoom, this morning, at the President's Office.

At the ceremony, the President welcomed Ambassador Polikha to the Maldives and congratulated him for presenting his credentials as the new Ambassador of Ukraine.

During the call, the President reflected on over two decades of bilateral relations between the Maldives and Ukraine. Diplomatic relations between the two countries was established on 17 August 1993.
