DUKE CITY RIDIN’ – This weekend, the elite Unleash The Beast returns to Albuquerque, New Mexico, for the second consecutive year and 25th time overall. The Pit will host the PBR for three days of action on Friday, March 24, starting at 6:45 p.m. MDT, Saturday, March 25, at 6:45 p.m. MDT, and concluding Sunday, March 26, at 1:45 p.m. MDT. This is the 17th event of the 2023 Unleash The Beast season with six events remaining until the 2023 PBR World Finals in Fort Worth, Texas, May 12-21. The Ty Murray Invitational is the second longest-running event on the PBR’s elite series, known for an intimate setting and attracting some of the most enthusiastic fans. Murray, a co-founder of PBR and PBR Ring of Honor member, is a nine-time World Champion and has been seen on PBR broadcasts since 2007.

PETRI TAKES THE BIG EASY – Jesse Petri stormed back into the top-10 with his first event win of the year in New Orleans last weekend. The affable Texan went 2-for-3 on the weekend, riding Dr. X in Round 1 for 87.75 points. He then secured the pick of the pen in the championship round thanks to an 86.25-point ride on Soul Train in Round 2. The bulls found the upper hand in the championship round, however, as not a single cowboy was able to post a qualified ride, including Petri, who was bucked off by Flapjack in 4.48 seconds. With his first victory since Manchester in October of 2021, Petri rocketed up to No. 9 in the UTB standings, 416 points behind Jose Vitor Leme. The win was also a welcome return to form for the Texan, as he had gone five events without recording a qualified ride after a solid start to the season. Petri’s previous best finish this season was second place in Manchester last December, and then he had two more top-10 finishes to start 2023, finishing fourth in New York seventh in Sacramento. Petri, who went 1-for-3 in Albuquerque last season, is slated to face Whiskey Glasses in Round 1 and Bandito Bug in the 15/15 Bucking Battle.

NATIVE AMERICAN INVITE – Every year, the Ty Murray Invitational invites the top Native American rider to compete alongside the world’s Top 40. This year’s invite will be 19-year-old Robbie Taylor Jr. of Chinle, Arizona. Taylor will be making his UTB debut after going 4-for-11 across the Touring Pro Division and the Velocity Tour, including three top-10 finishes, highlighted by his 10th place finish at the PWVT event in Denver in January of this year. Taylor went 1-for-2, riding Centerfold for 86.5 points in Round 1. Prior to joining the PBR, Taylor competed in high school before entering the Indian National Finals Rodeo in October of 2022, placing first after going 3-for-4.

SIDELINED LEME REMAINS NO. 1 – While unable to compete in Albuquerque this week due to injury, Jose Vitor Leme remains atop the Unleash The Beast standings for the seventh consecutive week after his second consecutive third place finish in New Orleans, going 2-for-3, and staying 107.5 points ahead of Dalton Kasel. After hanging onto Hog Wild for 72.5 points in Round 1, he rode Bread Basket in Round 2 for an impressive 88.5 points, but in the championship round was bucked off Fastfire, the second-ranked bull in the world. The previous weekend in Milwaukee, Leme went 2-for-3 to finish third, his first top-three finish since winning in Sacramento. The Brazilian dominated early in February, producing a six-out ride streak to begin the month that ended in the championship round in Tulsa after he had overtaken the No. 1 spot by winning and placing second in the 15/15 Bucking Battle the week before in Sacramento. In the two-time PBR World Champion’s first trip to California this season, he went a perfect 3-for-3, starting with an 85.5-point ride on Havoc in Round 1. Leme saved his best for Championship Sunday, putting up 89.5 points in a dance with Lil Hott in Round 2 before closing out his 26th career elite tour win with an 87.5-point ride on The Right Stuff. In addition to his Sacramento event win, Leme placed second in the 15/15 Bucking Battle by hanging on to Charmer for 86.75 points. It was the second time this season that the Brazilian champion had won an event and placed second in a Bucking Battle during the same weekend, as Leme went 3-for-3 in Chicago and placed second in the 15/15 Bucking Battle with another qualified ride on The Right Stuff, this time for 88 points. He started his perfect

weekend in the Windy City by hanging on to Reinstate Hank for 83.5 points and followed that up with an 87-point ride atop Knuckle Head. He then won his second buckle of 2023 with an 88.25-point, 8-second two-step with Cliff Hanger. In early January, Leme won his first event of 2023 in New York, going 3-for-4, starting his year with an 87.75-point ride atop Pickle Moonshine. He followed that up with an 86.5-point dance with Bad Decisions, and then closed the show by wowing the crowd at the Garden with a 92-point romp atop Cliff Hanger.

HOT TAKES – Ahead of this week’s PBR Ty Murray Invitational Presented by The Downs Racetrack & Casino in Albuquerque, New Mexico, here are a few other storylines to note:

- Mr. 90-point at it Again: Only one rider recorded a 90-point ride in New Orleans, so naturally it was Dalton Kasel, who danced with Raven for 90 points in Round 1. The Texan who sits at No. 2 in the Unleash The Beast standings 107.5 points behind Jose Vitor Leme, now has five 90-point rides on the season, two more than any other rider this year, and it secured his seventh elite round win of the season, also two more than any other rider. Kasel is slated to face Tortuga in Round 1 on Saturday and Centerfold in the 15/15 Bucking Battle on Friday, as he seeks his third win in the special round, which would give him two more 15/15 Bucking Battle victories than any other rider this season.
- New Faces: With The Pit showcasing 60 riders in Albuquerque, this weekend will be an opportunity for many riders to solidify a spot on the elite Unleash The Beast tour. Nine riders will be making their 2023 UTB debut, highlighted by Josh Frost, who is currently No. 2 in the standings on the Pendleton Whiskey Velocity Tour. Frost is currently an incredible 11-for-15 and has placed in the top-10 in all six events he has competed in this season, including five-straight top five finishes. He faces Ah Hell in Round 1 on Saturday. Claudio Montanha Jr. is currently first on the PWVT, 42.5 points ahead of Frost; he has competed on the premier series the last two weekends but has yet to record a qualified ride in his five outs. He is slated to dance with Casper in Round 1 on Friday.

FAMILIAR WATERS – Round 1 of the PBR Ty Murray Invitational Presented by The Downs Racetrack & Casino will feature eight rematches. Those familiar showdowns are:

- Alex Cerqueira tries to finally solve Drago, as the bovine athlete has successfully bucked of the Brazilian in all three previous matchups, most recently in Kansas City, Missouri, in March of 2021.
- Claudio Montanha Jr. completes a trilogy against Casper after the animal athlete successfully unseated the cowboy in the pair’s last two outings, most recently at the 2022 World Finals in Fort Worth.
- Dalton Kasel dances with Tortuga for the second time in his career, as “Mr. 90-point” was bucked off in 2.93 seconds when the two last shared a chute in Kansas City, Missouri, last March.
- Dener Barbosa is paired with Skeeter Peter for the second time, as the cowboy tries to repeat the 87.25-point duet the two posted when they were last matched up in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, in 2021.
- Joao Ricardo Vieira looks for this third-straight Round 1 ride in Albuquerque on Oilfield Outlaw’s Yellow Feather, who bucked him off in February of 2021 in Fort Worth.
- Kaique Pacheco faces off with Tested’s Viper for the second time, after he tangoed with his animal athlete compatriot for 87 points in Kansas City, Missouri in August last year during the PBR Team Series.
- Keyshawn Whitehorse hopes to repeat his phenomenal 91-point romp atop Kid Knapper the only time the two were previously matched in Tuscon, Arizona last November.
- Silvano Alves was bucked off by Hang Em High the last time the pair shared a chute in Little Rock, Arkansas, this March. Hang Em High has currently unseated all three riders he has faced this season.

PAST ALBUQUERQUE EVENT WINNERS – Joao Ricardo Vieira won last year in Albuquerque courtesy of a jaw-dropping perfect weekend, going 2-for-2 with two 90-point rides. The veteran Brazilian began the weekend with a 90.5-point romp atop Caddyshack, winning Round 1 and securing his pick of the pen for the final round. He chose the always-game Woopaa, who bucked in perfect time with Vieira for a career-high 94.25 points, securing the walk-off victory and bringing all in The Pit to their feet. Despite leading heading into the championship round, Vieira needed every single one of those 94.25

points, as Daylon Swearingen was right on his heels with two 90-point rides of his own, a 90.25-point ride on Bubba G in Round 1 and a 93-point ride on I'm Legit Too.

In 2019, the then Top 3 in the world standings, No. 1 Jose Vitor Leme, No. 2 Chase Outlaw and No. 3 Joao Ricardo Vieira, finished first, second and third, overall, respectively. Backed by the high-marked ride of the season, Leme won the championship round with a 92.75-point ride on Cochise en route to winning his second event title of the season. Also recording a 90-point score, 90 points aboard Bezerk in the final round, Outlaw finished second, with Viera rounding out the trifecta in third. Vieira's bronze finish was highlighted by a win in Round 3 after he reached the 8 on Sitting Bull for 88.75 points.

POINTS SYSTEM UPDATE – During the 2023 season, the PBR debuted a new points system, making the premier series even more important for determining the next World Champion while simplifying the points structure across all PBR tours. The biggest change is a move away from the world standings. The 2023 World Champion will now be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2023 PBR World Finals on May 12-21 in Fort Worth, Texas. There are three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2023: PBR Unleash The Beast (Nov. 26 – May 21); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Nov. 19 – May 6) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Nov. 4 – May 6). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as in PBR's international tours, are tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, also used to crown the 2023 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will be the essential currency for determining the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast events, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points will now be awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.

THIS WEEKEND’S FORMAT – The PBR Ty Murray Invitational Presented by The Downs Racetrack & Casino in Albuquerque, New Mexico, the 17th Unleash The Beast event of the 2023 season, will feature two long rounds and a championship round of bull riding in addition to a 15/15 Bucking Battle. Each of the 60 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday or Saturday. Following the conclusion of the first round on Saturday, there will be a 15/15 Bucking Battle with 15 of the top ranked cowboys in the UTB standings. On Sunday, those riders seeded, invited, or using an injury exemption will automatically advance to Round 2, accompanied by any of the other alternates who register a score in Round 1. The riders with the Top 12 scores will advance to the championship round later that evening.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Sioux Falls, South Dakota, for the PBR First Premier Bank/Premier Bankcard Invitational Presented by Cooper Tires. The event will be on Friday, March 31, at 7:45 p.m. CDT, Saturday, April 1, at 6:45 p.m. CDT, and Sunday, April 2, at 2:45 p.m. CDT.

PROVIDING PROTECTION – This weekend’s bullfighters are Cody Webster of Wayne, Oklahoma; Lucas Teodoro of Pinhal, Brazil; and Beau Schueth of O’Neill, Nebraska.

ALBUQUERQUE 15/15 BUCKING BATTLE

After posting an 88.25-point ride on Chiseled in Sacramento to win the third 15/15 Bucking Battle of the 2023 season, Dalton Kasel pairs up with Centerfold in search of his third special round win of the year. The Texas superstar has dominated the Bucking Battles this season – winning in Sacramento as well as the first special round of the year with an 89.75-point ride on Roc With It in Chicago in January and placing second in Indianapolis with an incredible 92 points on Tulsa Time. Kaique Pacheco was able to best Mr. 90-Point in Indy, bringing all of Gainbridge Field House to their feet with an incredible 93-point dance atop Ricky Vaughn, the highest-marked ride in a 15/15 Bucking Battle this season.

Last year in Albuquerque, The Pit hosted two 15/15 Bucking Battles, with Dalton Kasel and Kaique Pacheco finishing 1st and 2nd, respectively, in both special rounds. On Friday, Kasel posted a 91.25-point ride on Hang Em High, with Pacheco right on his heels, putting up 90.5 points on Moonlight Party. The two continued to bring it on Saturday, as Kasel, in front of a raucous crowd at The Pit, rode WSM's Nasty Wishes for 91.5 points. Pacheco was unable to keep pace with the Texan, as the Ice Man lasted the 8 for 88.25 points on Midnight Flyer.

THE BEAST PIT – ULTIMATE BULLFIGHTERS AT THE TY MURRAY INVITATIONAL

In addition to traditional bull riding and the 15/15 Bucking Battle, Albuquerque will also host The Beast Pit, a 3-day Progressive Format sanctioned by the Ultimate Bullfighters Freestyle Bullfighting League. Friday and Saturday will feature 3 athletes with the winner from each night advancing to a head-to-head shootout round on Sunday with the highest score in the final round determining the winner.

Dekevis Jordan – Madill, OK

Dekevis was the reserve World Champion in 2022 with nearly \$50,000 in earnings in the season. Jordan is also an accomplished protection bullfighter as he serves as one of the regular faces of the protection team on the Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour.

Wagner Miqueline – Zacarias, SP, BRA

Wagner or "Pessimo" as he is known around the locker room is the oldest active athlete in the UBF at 38 years old. After finally coming to the U.S. from Brazil, Miqueline's biggest goal was to compete on the world's largest stage of bullfighting. At the end of last season, he accomplished his goal by maintaining a Top 10 position in the world standings

Chance Moorman – Lytle, TX

The 2022 and now 2-time World Champion from Texas is the bar-setter in freestyle bullfighting. In 2022 he set nearly very record imaginable: most 90+ point bullfights in a regular season, most event wins in a regular season, and most money earned in a single season. Moorman, who started his bullfighting career at the age of 15, has dedicated every waking moment of his career to being one step better than the last, and is on a path towards becoming a legend in the game of freestyle bullfighting.

Saturday:

Tyler Mansell – Caldwell, ID

The 2022 BFO Champion from Caldwell, ID, has a flashy sense of recklessness that goes unmatched in the ring. By perfectly executing death-defying moves to sell the judges, he is almost always a sure bet to appear in the championship round of competition on any given weekend.

Broc Bowman – Barnsdall, OK

The 2022 UBF Rookie of the Year came onto the scene late in the 2022 season but several solid showings in the Fall gave him enough points to qualify to the UBF World Finals where he advanced all the way to the championship round of the 7-day format and eventually would leave Fort Worth, TX with nearly \$25,000 in prize money.

Clay Moore – Belen, NM

Clay Moore was born into the world of bull riding and western sports. His grandfather, Casper Baca, was one of the most legendary western sports promoters in the Southwest and frequently hauled bulls to the Ty Murray Invitational PBR. Clay himself is a 3x qualifier to the UBF World Finals and now resides in Oklahoma where he works and trains alongside PBR Bullfighter, Frank Newsom.

About UBF

The UBF (Ultimate Bullfighting) was launched in 2020 as a partnership between **Luke Kaufman**, 2020 UBF Stock Contractor of the Year **Chad Ellison** and two-time PBR World Champion **J.B. Mauney** (Statesville, North Carolina), showcasing the acrobatic western discipline of freestyle bullfighting. After awarding \$237,000 in prize money in its inaugural season, the UBF paid out more than \$550,000 at the conclusion of 2022.

In freestyle bullfighting, a bullfighter competes for 60 seconds against a Spanish fighting bull in an effort to score points for maneuvers performed during the one-minute competition. Unlike traditional bullfighting, the animals are not harmed. Bullfighters are judged solely on their ability to perform gravity-defying acrobatic stunts as close to the bull as possible without getting hit.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events will now award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events, and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The points system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier, will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events – \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events – \$10,000 - \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events – \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events will now receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
