

2024 PBR Unleash The Beast PBR Tucson Tucson Arena – Tucson, Arizona Friday, November 10 at 7:45 p.m. MST Saturday, November 11 at 6:45 p.m. MST

BACK TO BUCKING – This weekend PBR will launch the 2024 Unleash The Beast season in Tucson, Arizona, at Tucson Arena. The first event of the 24-event 2024 individual season will mark the fifth time in history the premier series has traveled to Tucson and the second consecutive year. The Grand Canyon State will host the PBR for two days of action on Friday, November 10 at 7:45 p.m. MST and Saturday, November 11 at 6:45 p.m. MST.

FAMILIAR FACES AND SOME NEW KIDS ON THE BLOCK – As the PBR returns to individual competition with the conclusion of the second season of the PBR Camping World Team Series, there are several riders to keep an eye on competing in Tucson, Arizona:

Cassio Dias – The best rookie during the 2023 PBR Teams season, Dias went an incredible 20-for-28 throughout the regular season and playoffs, coming just one ride short (87 points) of the PBR Teams MVP. The young Brazilian led the league in riding percentage (73.1%) and tied for the league lead with five 90-point rides. He won event MVP in both Nashville, Tennessee, and Greensboro, North Carolina, and propelled the Kansas City Outlaws to an 18-10 record, No. 2 in the regular season. While the Outlaws were upset in Round 2 of the PBR Teams Championship by the Arizona Ridge Riders, Dias converted in his first postseason out aboard War Daddy for 86.75 points, proving no moment is too big for the up-and-coming star. Dias takes on Younts Brody's Pet in Round 1 on Friday.

Caden Bunch – The Oklahoman had a breakout season while competing for his home state Oklahoma Freedom on the PBR Camping World Team Series. He finished 11th in the MVP race and led the Freedom by going 11-for-17 throughout the regular season and playoffs. One of the most consistent riders throughout the season, Bunch never had more than two consecutive buckoffs, and he looks to bring that consistency to the Unleash The Beast tour in 2024. He shares a chute with Ah Hell in Round 1 on Friday.

Joao Ricardo Vieira – The grizzled 39-year-old veteran was nothing short of spectacular for the 2023 PBR Teams Champion Texas Rattlers, going 16-for-28 and finishing 6th in the MVP race. Vieira, who has twice finished runner-up for a gold buckle, turned it on when his team needed it most, going a perfect 4-for-4 at the PBR Teams Championship to lead the Texas Rattlers to victory and securing the event MVP in the process. In Round 1 on Friday, the Brazilian faces off against Nitty Gritty.

Jose Vitor Leme – After coming up just short of his third gold buckle for the second time in 2023, Leme was in top form for the Austin Gamblers during the 2023 PBR Teams season. The two-time World Champion won his second PBR Teams MVP award (meaning he is still the only rider in history to hold the title of PBR Teams MVP) and led the Austin Gamblers to their second-consecutive regular season No. 1 ranking, as the team finished 19-9. Leme was the only rider with multiple Extra Out rides, and he tied for the league lead with five 90-point performances. Now sporting blonde hair, the Brazilian also went a perfect 3-for-3 at the PBR Teams Championship in Las Vegas as the Austin Gamblers came one win shy of taking home their first championship. Leme takes on a familiar foe in Hostage in Round 1 Friday evening.

John Crimber – While he didn't make his debut on the PBR Challenger Series until mid-August, the day after he turned 18, Crimber proved he is one of the most exciting prospects the PBR has ever had. Son of PBR legend Paulo Crimber, the young gun won an incredible nine Challenger Series events in just three months to skyrocket up the rankings, ending the season No. 2 in the Challenger Global standings. Not satisfied, Crimber then headed up north to Canada, where he dominated in his first event, winning the PBR Canada Cup Series event in Saskatoon, Saskatchewan. Making his long-awaited premier series debut, Crimber is tasked with Border Wall in Round 1 on Friday. Heralded as a generational talent, Crimber is being talked about as a lock to be selected No. 1 overall in the 2024 PBR Teams Draft.

MAJORS RETURN – The 2024 PBR Unleash The Beast season begins Friday night in Tucson, Arizona, keeping the same point structure as 2023 but adding back in PBR Majors while removing 15/15 Bucking Battles and having two separate aggregates at the PBR World Finals. The 2024 World Champion will be the rider who earns the most points only at Unleash The Beast (UTB) events, including at the 2024 PBR World Finals on May 10-19 in the Dallas-Fort Worth Metroplex. The three PBR Majors in New York City (January 5-7), Sacramento, California, (February 2-4) and Albuquerque, New Mexico, (March 22-24) will offer increased payouts and points. There will be three PBR tours in the U.S. in action for the first half of 2024: PBR Unleash The Beast (November 10 - May 19); Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour (Jan. 5 - May 4) and PBR Touring Pro Division (Oct. 19 - May 19). Points accumulated in non-UTB events domestically, as well as PBR's international tours, will be tallied as Velocity Global points. Velocity Global points, which will also be used to crown the 2024 PBR Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour Champion, will help determine the athletes who can earn a future draw spot on the elite Unleash The Beast following the tour's first four events.

Those with the most points earned during their four most recent Velocity Global or Unleash The Beast events will join the UTB, replacing riders who had fallen to the bottom of the pack during select cuts throughout the season. The first rider cut takes place after the fourth UTB event in Manchester, New Hampshire, on Dec. 15-16. Riders ranked in the No. 36-40 range in the UTB Standings will be subject to being cut. During each cut, the open positions will first be filled with those riders having injury exemptions, followed by the Premier Series Qualifier List, based on Velocity Global points. Following the first cut, these riders will take the place of the demoted riders in the sport's top series to make up the 40-rider field heading into Albany, New York on Dec. 29-30. Riders ranked No. 1-35 on the UTB will remain on the PBR's elite tour. Following the initial cut, subsequent cuts will be held every two weeks. The second cut will drop the bottom six riders from UTB, the third cut will drop the bottom seven riders, and the fourth and remaining cuts will remove the bottom eight riders from UTB.

Points will be awarded as follows for the Unleash The Beast, including World Finals, as well as Tier 1 Velocity Global events:

Bonus points are awarded across all levels of PBR competition. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points. The exception is if a contestant declines a re-ride due to an inferior bull. In that case, he does not earn bonus points.

LET'S TALK QUALIFIERS – As the new Unleash The Beast (UTB) season gets underway, below is the qualification system when competition begins in Tucson. The field is determined via a combination of factors, including a rider's performance on the PBR Team Camping World Team Series, which concluded its second season in late October.

Here are the criteria the PBR will use to determine the riders who will compete at the first four Unleash The Beast events in Tucson, St. Louis, Johnstown and Manchester:

- All PBR World Champions who competed in at least one 2023 UTB event and/or qualified for the 2023 PBR World Finals.
- The Top 15 riders from the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series standings who are not already qualified through PBR World Champion status. The Top-15 was determined by the cumulative ride scores of individual riders across all outs at PBR Teams events, including Extra Outs and PBR Teams Championship events during the season.
- The Top 5 riders from the 2023 PBR Challenger Series standings, who are not already qualified through the above criteria, will earn qualification. For clarity, if one of the Top 5 riders in the Challenger Series standings is already qualified, the rider ranked No. 6 will then get the position, and so on.
- The two highest-ranking riders who finished in the Top 40 in the 2023 PBR world standings who also competed in the previous year's PBR World Finals and are not already qualified through any of the above scenarios.
- Eight riders selected by their respective teams from the year-end active rosters.
- Any remaining positions will be filled with a maximum of 10 additional riders based on the PBR Teams cumulative ride score standings, who must have finished in the Top 40 in the previous year's PBR world standings and/or competed in the previous year's PBR World Finals.

Following the first four events, the Unleash The Beast field will be set via the tour's standings and subject to the rolling cuts as identified above.

FAMILIAR WATERS - Round 1 of the 2024 PBR season-launch event in Tucson, Arizona, will feature four rematches.

- Briggs Madsen faces off against Blackstone for the second time after the animal athlete bested him in 3.56 seconds in Big Sky, Montana, in July of 2023.
- Jesse Petri dances with Lone Star for the second time after he was bucked off in 2.26 seconds in the first matchup in Sacramento, California, in January of 2022.

- Jose Vitor Leme shares a chute with Hostage for the eighth time on Friday. Leme was bucked off in 2.57 seconds in the pair's first meeting in Los Angeles, California, in February of 2019, but the Brazilian got his revenged in Tulsa, Oklahoma, later that year in August, covering for 91.25 points. The two-time World Champion was once again bucked off in 2.19 seconds in Guthrie, Oklahoma, in April of 2020 but bounced back for 90 points the next time the two met in Rocksprings, Texas, on June 26, 2020. After the pair were unable to make it out the gate in Sioux Falls, South Dakota, in July of 2020, the bovine competitor got the better of Leme in the last two matchups, bucking him off in 1.59 and 1.24 seconds, respectively in Nashville, Tennessee, in August of 2022 and Louisville, Kentucky, in April of 2023.
- Koltin Hevalow successfully made the 8 for 87.5 points in his first matchup with Cherry Bomb in Anaheim, California, in August of 2023.

PAST TUCSON EVENT WINNERS – Last season in Tucson, Brady Oleson went a perfect 3-for-3 to take home the first event buckle of the season. Round 1 ended in a three-way tie, as Oleson, Cooper Davis and Daniel Keeping all made the 8 for 89.75 points in their first out of the season. The Idahoan punched his ticket to the final round by covering White Face for 88 points in Round 2, and then selected Pickle Moonshine to be his final animal athlete opponent. With fans inside Tucson Arena cheering him on, Oleson rocketed out of the gate and scored a monstrous 90.75 points to take back the lead with just three riders left to buck. Confident he had given it his all, the 26-year-old cowboy watched from the chutes as Vitor Losnake, Chase Outlaw and Boudreaux Campbell all bucked off to give Oleson his first career UTB win.

WORLD CHAMPION BULL UPDATE – The 2024 YETI PBR World Champion bull will be determined by both the 2023 PBR Camping World Team Series season and the 2024 Unleash The Beast (UTB) season. The 2024 World Champion Bull will be determined by their Top 8 outs during the Team Series and UTB regular season and two outs at the PBR World Finals. The Top 7 eligible bulls at the end of a PBR UTB regular season shall be entered into the World Finals and be guaranteed three outs. In the event two or more bulls are tied based on the scoring criteria after the World Finals, the World Champion Bull shall be awarded to the bull who has achieved the highest average score from their two best outs at the World Finals. If a tie still exists after a review of the scores described in the preceding sentence, the bulls will share the title of World Champion Bull, and the prize money will be evenly distributed among the Stock Contractors who own said bulls.

For avoidance of doubt, if the score that is dropped from the World Finals is higher than the lowest regular season out, the score at World Finals will still be dropped. The top eight (8) regular season outs, and top two (2) World Finals outs are to remain in the calculations for the World Champion Bucking Bull Award.

THIS WEEKEND'S FORMAT – PBR Tucson, in Tucson, Arizona, the first Unleash The Beast event of the 2024 season, will feature three rounds of bull riding. Each of the 38 competing riders will get on one bull in Round 1 on Friday and Round 2 on Saturday. The 12 bull riders with the top combined ride scores following Rounds 1-2 will then advance to the championship round following Round 2 on Saturday.

NEXT UP – The PBR Unleash The Beast next travels to Enterprise Center in St. Louis, Missouri, for PBR St. Louis. The event will be on Saturday, December 2, at 6:45 p.m. CST and Sunday, December 3 at 1:45 p.m. CST.

VELOCITY TOUR, INTERNATIONAL AND TOURING PRO DIVISION POINTS – All non-Unleash The Beast (UTB) events award Velocity Global points, including Pendleton Whisky Velocity Tour events, Touring Pro Division events and events held internationally in Australia, Brazil, Canada, and Mexico. The only exception is National Finals held abroad, which will only award national points, not Velocity Global points. The point system at each event is tiered based on added money in USD, and other factors determined by the PBR. Each event, depending on the tier will get points in accordance with the tables below.

- Tier 1 Events \$20,000 or more USD in added money.
- Tier 2 Events \$10,000 \$19,999 USD in added money.
- Tier 3 Events \$9,999 USD or less in added money.

Additionally, riders at all events receive bonus points via their ride score. A rider who scores 70-79.75 points will earn 7 bonus points, 80-89.75 8 bonus points and 90-99.75 9 bonus points.
