Creative Arts Summer School (14-16 years) 2 week course: 29th July - 9th August 2019

- Drawing & Illustration Graphic Design
- Fashion Photography Animation
- Printmaking & Mixed Media
- Make-up for Stage and Screen

- Model Making & 3D Design

This course has been specifically designed for young students who have a keen interest in art, design and media who wish to develop their artistic talents. Over two weeks the summer school delivers an exciting, hands-on course that combines creative teaching with stimulating workshops and practical sessions so that students can explore creative pathways and develop skills for their future.

CASS Residential Programme

If you join our Creative Arts Summer School (CASS), you can also choose to book onto our residential programme. This is a fully catered package providing everything you will need alongside your course. This includes accommodation in our University Halls of Residence, all meals, weekend excursions, evening social activities, London airport transfer (if required) and daily campus bus transfers.

Creative Thinking and Skills Development (18+ years) 2 week course: 29th July - 9th August 2019

This new course has been created for current university students, graduates and creative professionals who wish to develop key skills to support and enhance their creative output. Students will be presented with a series of short projects in a variety of creative disciplines designed to foster independent thinking and critical reflection. These encourage each individual to develop a toolkit of creative thinking techniques to positively enhance their work.

Campus learning will be complemented with study day trips to iconic places of interest such as London and Bath, to help contextualise studio and workshop activities and inspire students' own creative work.



3 week courses: 23rd July - 9th August 2019 (16+ years)

British Architecture & Design

This course is based around the creative processes of 'thinking and making' to enhance your understanding of architectural design. You will develop your drawing and digital skills and also produce a 3D model from your design. Course study trips will underpin your studio sessions with visits to significant buildings and public spaces, including London and Bath.

Introduction to Animation

Gain an insight into the world of animation and production by exploring hand drawn techniques, cut out and stop motion. You will be introduced to the 12 principles of animation, learning traditional and contemporary techniques. Working in small groups, you will produce your own piece of animated film for screening at the end of the course.

Creative Makeup Academy

Discover how to plan, create and apply a variety of make-up styles and special effects for film, television and theatre. You'll learn a range of core technical and creative techniques and will be encouraged to experiment and develop your own style. A number of these finished 'looks' will be recorded in a series of professional photo shoots to add to your portfolio or cv.

Drawing & Illustration

Whether you are a budding illustrator or simply wish to improve your drawing skills to support other creative work, this new course gives you the chance to get stuck in with a range of different mediums and develop your drawing techniques. You will participate in a broad range of drawing workshops including sessions on location to inspire you as well as life drawing and other still life.



Fashion Design & Styling

Explore key concepts in fashion and develop your knowledge of the industry. From sketchbooks and research through to recording fashion shapes and understanding fabric, a series of practical workshops and inspirational study sessions will enhance your design knowledge, critical awareness and develop your fashion illustration skills. The course includes a day-trip to London and professional photoshoot of your styled fashion look.

Practical Filmmaking

From scriptwriting to finished film, this intense course offers the chance to learn about the fundamentals of filmmaking while gaining much-needed practical experience with industry-standard equipment. You will have the opportunity to work with live actors on set and learn the art of directing. Finished films will be screened at the end of the course for group critique and to add to your showreel.

Portfolio Preparation for the Arts

Ideal for those with an interest and passion for creative arts who wish to experience a variety of artistic subjects. You will gain confidence in your abilities and produce work for your physical and digital portfolio exploring subjects including Drawing and Illustration, Graphic Design, Fashion and Textiles, Photography and Film, Architecture, Mixed Media and Print Making. Your course tutors will offer guidance and feedback on your work as well as support and advice on your future creative studies.

Please go to the course webpage you are interested in and click on the 'Book Now' link. Our online booking system allows you to book and pay onto your chosen course yourself.


Additional options such as our Residential Programme and private taxi transfer can also be booked through AUB's online store, once you have selected your summer course.
