## 3. Overall Responsibilities

The Research & Risk Analyst will contribute technical inputs for MRPS related investments and other member benefits while undertaking all responsibilities related to Risk Management functions of MRPS.

#### 4. Specific Duties





- Conducting research on risk and return characteristics on asset classes.
- Conducting portfolio analysis, measuring and assessing the risks within investment portfolios.
- Setting appropriate risk limits, monitoring of these limits and escalating issues as appropriate.
- Measurement and assessment of portfolio liquidity.
- Generating risk reports for management, board, and external regulators as required.
- Preparing quarterly and semi-annual risk reports for management, board, and external regulators and managing an annual review of the risk management process and risk profiles.
- Presentation of Risk reports to relevant stakeholders as required, covering all aspects of risk measurement and assessment.
- Development of policies for implementing risk management functions.
- Forecasting predictive models and developing scenarios to support the investment management practices.
- Preparing investment due diligence and other technical reports related to MRPS investments and other member benefits.
- Any other relevant tasks assigned by the Head of Investment Advisory Services or the Chief Financial Officer.

### 5. Minimum Qualifications / Work Experience

- A Bachelor's Degree in the field of Economics, Finance or Investment.
- A minimum 3 years of experience, working in a relevant field.
