### Day 1: Arrival in Edinburgh

- Arrive at Edinburgh Airport

- Afternoon: Explore Dunvegan Castle
- Evening: Relax at your accommodation

### **Day 8: Travel to Glasgow**

- Morning: Drive or take a bus from Isle of Skye to Glasgow (approx. 5 hours)
- Afternoon: Visit Kelvingrove Art Gallery
- Evening: Explore the West End's restaurants and bars

### **Day 9: Glasgow**

- Morning: Visit Glasgow Cathedral and Necropolis
- Afternoon: Explore the Riverside Museum and Tall Ship
- Evening: Enjoy a traditional Scottish dinner

- Afternoon: Transfer to Glasgow Airport for departure
