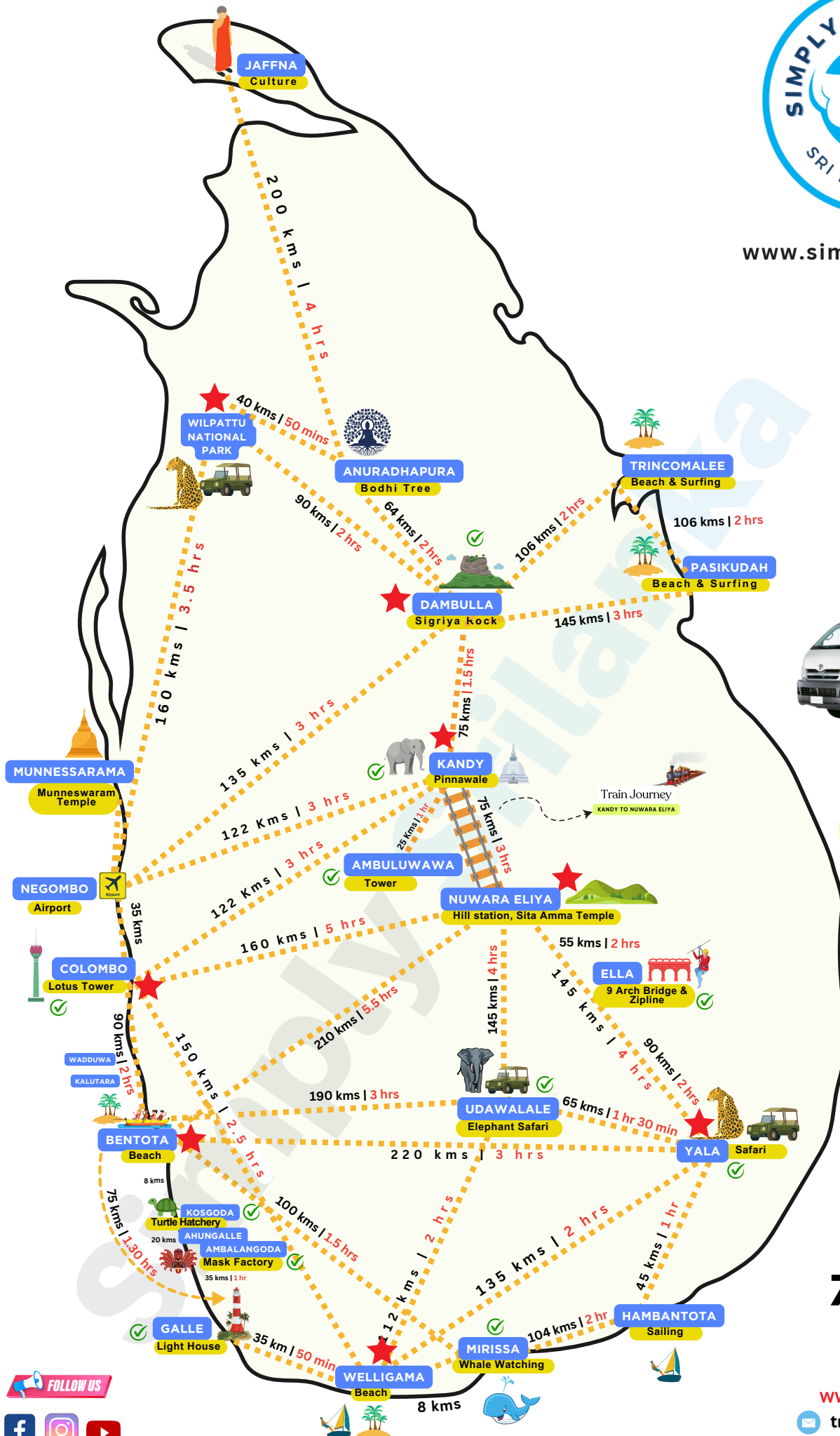

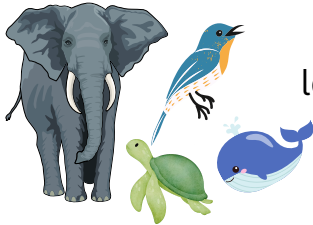

- Udawalawe National Park:** Famous for its **large population of elephants**, Udawalawe offers excellent opportunities for wildlife enthusiasts to observe these majestic creatures in their natural habitat.
- Minneriya National Park:** Home to the "**Gathering**" of elephants, where herds congregate around the Minneriya Tank, creating a breathtaking spectacle.
- Horton Plains National Park:** A UNESCO World Heritage Site, Horton Plains is known for its scenic beauty, unique flora, and the **stunning viewpoint known as World's End**.
- Wasgamuwa National Park:** This park is rich in biodiversity, featuring a mix of dry and evergreen forests and providing a habitat for **elephants, sloth bears, and numerous bird species**.
- Gal Oya National Park:** Recognized for its unique boat safaris, Gal Oya allows visitors to spot wildlife along the shores of Senanayake Samudraya, **Sri Lanka's largest reservoir**.

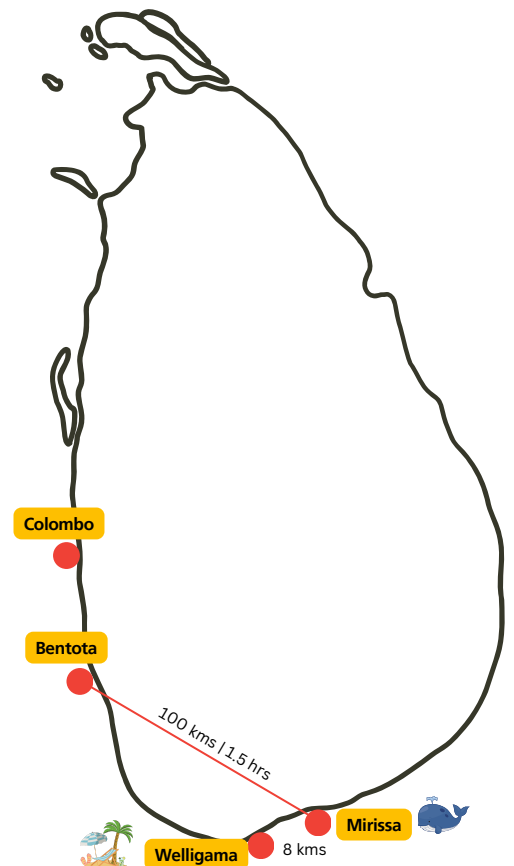


Whale watching in Mirissa, Sri Lanka, is a fascinating and memorable experience. Its recommendable for one to stay in Welligama!



Sri Lanka is rapidly gaining fame in the whale -watching world for the opportunities to observe blue whales in at least two different locations between December and July.

The most frequently targeted species of whale for whale watching in Sri Lanka is the blue whale, which can be observed off the coast of Mrissa between December and March, and off Trincomalee between March and July. Bryde's whales and sperm whales are sometimes also opportunistically observed during trips that are focused on blue whales. Whale watching platforms range in size from small boats seating 4-6 passengers to large double-decked vessels taking up to 300 passengers. Tours sometimes head up to 20 km offshore, so vessels need to be large and powerful enough to cope with longer journeys and potentially rough sea conditions.
