- **Reykjavik** (1 Day): Arrival and explore the capital.
- **Golden Circle** (2 Days): Þingvellir, Gullfoss, Geysir.
- **Vík** (1 Day): South Coast, Seljalandsfoss, Skógafoss.
- **Höfn** (2 Days): Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon, Diamond Beach.
- **Snaefellsnes Peninsula** (2 Days): Kirkjufell Mountain, Arnastapi cliffs.
- **Reykjavik** (2 Days): Blue Lagoon, Northern Lights (optional).

## Best Time to Visit

- **Summer (June to August):** Long days, midnight sun, warmer weather.
- **Winter (November to February):** Best for Northern Lights.

## Itinerary (with popular & offbeat places)

### Day 1: Arrival in Reykjavík

- Explore Reykjavík's Old Town and Hallgrímskirkja Church

- Overnight in Reykjavík

## **Day 2: Golden Circle**

- Thingvellir National Park, Geysir Geothermal Area, Gullfoss Waterfall
- Overnight near Gullfoss

## **Day 3-4: South Coast**

- Seljalandsfoss and Skógafoss Waterfalls, Reynisfjara Beach
- Drive to Jökulsárlón Glacier Lagoon and Diamond Beach
- Overnight in Vík

## **Day 5: Snæfellsnes Peninsula**

- Explore black sand beaches, lava fields, and Kirkjufell Mountain
- Overnight in Snæfellsnes

## **Day 6: Continue Snæfellsnes**

- Visit Snæfellsjökull National Park, volcanic craters, and fishing villages
- Overnight near Borgarnes

## **Day 7: Return to Reykjavík**

- Explore museums and shops, visit Perlan Museum
- Optional: Whale watching tour
- Overnight in Reykjavík

## **Day 8: Blue Lagoon**

- Relax in the Blue Lagoon Spa before your return journey
- Overnight near the Blue Lagoon

## **Day 9: Departure from Reykjavík**

- Drive to Keflavík Airport for your flight home

## Distance Chart

- Reykjavik to Golden Circle: 300 km (loop)
- Golden Circle to Vík: 180 km
- Vík to Jökulsárlón: 200 km
- Jökulsárlón to Snaefellsnes Peninsula: 400 km
- Snaefellsnes to Reykjavik: 150 km
