

### A Message from our President and Publisher:

As LGBTQ+ people we have struggled for years for equal representation in the media. While we have made great strides in media representation in entertainment, we have yet to receive equal representation in the news media. There are fewer open gay, lesbian, transgender, or non-gender/binary conforming news reporters in news media then there are representatives of other minorities.



Historically, the portrayals of LGBTQ+ communities in media have been negative, reflecting the cultural intolerance of LGBTQ+ individuals. While there has been an increase in the depictions of LGBTQ+ people, and issues within mainstream media in North America.<sup>1</sup> It has been the LGBTQ+ people who have taken an increasingly proactive stand in defining their own culture with a primary goal of achieving an affirmative visibility in mainstream media. The positive portrayal or increased presence of the LGBTQ+ communities in media has served to increase acceptance and support for LGBTQ+ communities, establish LGBTQ+ communities as a norm, and provide information on the topic.<sup>1</sup>

However, there are still many great strides to make as we are still under-represented in print, television, radio and online news media. And with recent world events the world landscape and our place in it has changed. A global pandemic has "changed the game" on nearly every aspect of our lives. In conservative and evangelical media we are lambasted and vilified. And recent political upheavals have changed the political landscape for everyone in the country. In Milwaukee in recent years we have been lacking a guide and a voice in our community.

At *Milwaukee Pride Life* we want to strive to do more then just report the news and events that are important to our community; we also want to be its beacon in troubling times and its voice where it has previously had none. But a LGBTQ+ news outlet is nothing without the support of the community it represents. We hope you join us in our mission and support our publication and website by advertising with us both in print and online.

LGBTQ+ media has been key in the fight for equal rights, health and safety over the years for the community. Please help us in continuing this fight for by supporting us.






