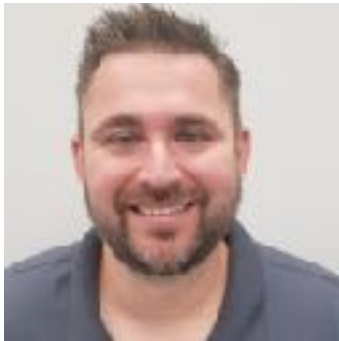

The Employment Opportunities Section of Our Newsletter


This section of our newsletter seems to be a popular page to visit.
