Dr. Thomas C. Voigt
CEO of Lyfebrdge

"IoT in Healthcare and the Evolution of Patient Care In The Years to Come"

From East German political prisoner to leading fortune 100 company division, Dr. Thomas C. Voigt's journey is one of helping the world achieve a better standard of patient care.

As a lead scientist working with Siemens AG in Erlangen, Bavaria, Germany, Dr. Voigt led the development in Siemens of digital radiology product family, including digital mammography and was part of the team that brought to life the world's first digital hospital in Vienna, Austria.

He came to Pittsburgh in 2000, responsible for the merger of Siemens and Westinghouse in Western Pennsylvania as the President. His career achievements include cancer detection technology, called Molecular Imaging using patented tuning hyper-spectral cameras, semiconductor device development for telecommunication for the first ESA-NASA German Mission project, served as key member of the "High Level Group" in Brussels for USA and EU to develop strategies and solutions for hydrogen energy and is supporting CMU's intelligent building sensor technologies for smart city development.

Currently, Dr. Voigt is the CEO of Lyfebrdge, a health care disruptor in the medical IoT space. His product, **the LyfeBrdge Ring**, utilizes LED multi-wavelength technology to measure patient vital signs with light transmission through the blood stream. It presents medical-grade accurate measurements in

addition to reflection technology found in most fitness watches and rings. LyfeBrdge holds the vision of "Improving the standard of Patient Care one finger at a time."

Their offices are in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. They Dr Thomas C Voigtcollaborate with several local and national partners.


