Meningococcal	Meningococcal vaccine (anti-meningitis vaccine)		
MMR	Measles, Mumps, Rubella vaccine

Rotavirus	Rotavirus vaccine to prevent rotavirus stomach flu		
Tdap	Tetanus, diphtheria, and acellular pertussis vaccine
