SET FREE

Have you been set Free? Are you willing to die for Christ? Are you willing to live for Christ? "Now the Lord is the Spirit, and where the Spirit of the Lord is there is freedom." 2 Cor. 3:17

Thank God that we don't have to count on anyone but Jesus for our freedom! I'm reminded of a phrase I heard a while back, "If you complain you will remain." I can't remember the author of that, but it has stuck with me and also reminds me of who we are supposed to be in the Lord.

As believers we know the Spirit of the Lord is in us and we have freedom in all areas of life, so why would we complain? Let's look at *Acts 16:22-31*. Paul and Silas had a reason to complain but they didn't. Just imagine, they were stripped and beaten with rods and thrown into prison with their feet fastened in stocks for their faith. Even so, they praised God through singing hymns and praying. They continued to praise the Lord, sharing their faith with the jailer and his family and as a result God moved in an amazing way through them.

After the earthquake the jailer called for lights, rushed in and fell trembling before Paul and Silas. He then brought them out and asked, "Sirs, what must I do to be saved?" They replied "Believe in the Lord Jesus, and you will be saved—you and your household." Then they spoke the word of the Lord to him and to all others in his house. At that hour of the night the jailer took them and washed their wounds; then immediately he and all his household were baptized. The jailer brought them into his house and set a meal before them; he was filled with joy because he had come to believe in God (he and his whole household). This is a powerful story of the Resurrection Power of our Lord Jesus and how He changes lives from bondage to freedom.

We have just celebrated Resurrection Sunday as a church and my prayer is that we will know beyond a shadow of a doubt that the same God that set Paul and Silas, the jailer and his household free is still setting people free everyday. HE wants us to join HIM in spreading His Good News so that 'whosoever will come to a personal relationship with Jesus.' Remember, you are free because of Jesus now, so we are called to tell others how to be set free. Who are you sharing the Good News with?
