Eric Flynn is a veteran snowsports innovator, having served in many roles with the major industry trade association and as a top executive with one of Pennsylvania's leading winter resort corporations, Snow Time Inc.

Eric currently serves as Vice President and Chief Operating Officer of the parent company of central Pennsylvania's Liberty, Roundtop and Whitetail resorts and as Chairman of the National Ski Areas Association, representing 325 Alpine resorts across North America.

Eric's service to the development of skiing and snowboarding in Pennsylvania is extensive. From his role in the Pennsylvania Ski areas Association to his advocacy for the Pennsylvania SnowSports Museum, his efforts have been tireless.

Our host for the 2012 Hall of Fame induction, Eric Flynn has served the Hall of Fame Committee and the Pennsylvania Winter Sports Museum over the years and was responsible for the development of the first satellite display at Liberty Mountain Resort.

With over 30 years in the ski industry, the nominee has developed close ties to the volunteer organizations that form the backbone of recreational skiing and snowboarding. He has personally worked with the ski patrollers who cover the 3 Snow Time resorts and strongly advocated for solid Safety and Education Learning Centers. For his work, Eric was awarded an Honorary National Ski Patrol appointment.

Since his 1984 introduction to the Snow Time Pennsylvania properties, Eric has championed the employees and volunteers who work in often harsh winter conditions. His most recent contribution to their welfare has been the creation of an on-the-job health and accident benefit policy.

His accomplishments in the snowsports arena and his contribution to skiing and snowboarding in Pennsylvania make Eric Flynn a worthy inductee into the Pennsylvania SnowSports Hall of Fame – Class of 2012.
