*Please use no more than 3 pages, or 1.5 sheets of paper. Our mascot will be doing a lot of visiting, and I want to make sure there is room for all of their adventures.

*Please take a few pictures of your child with our mascot. You can print from your phone at a local discount store, but you can also print from a computer on plain paper. Then trim as needed and glue stick into the notebook. Your child can also use crayon or colored pencil to draw a picture of their adventures. Please don't use markers because that bleeds through the pages.

*Please write *your child's words* about the pictures. Please don't worry too much about grammar. Just help get your child's thoughts put down.

*This is an exercise for many skills. Literacy, responsibility, "public speaking", courtesy. Your child will stand in front of our class and tell us about their time with our mascot. Classmates will need to raise their hands, and your child will be calling on them to answer questions and receive comments.

*Please be sure to return our bear the Monday following your child's turn as superhero. This is when your child will share about their adventures and pass it to the new superhero of the week.
