LEARNING FOCUS

In March, we will begin to work on some more complex skills in both math and reading. In math, we will begin to examine some simple addition and subtraction as well as frequently practice counting beyond 30. In ELA, we will work on decoding and encoding simple CVC words. Rhyme recognition and production will also be a focal point of instruction this month.

As we continue to work on lowercase letter formation, students are becoming more automatic and fluent with handwriting.
