

Oregon's Legendary Goldens

Purchase Agreement and Spay and Neuter Contract

This contract is between Oregon's Oodles of Poodles & Doodles (Hereafter "Seller") and ______ (Hereafter "Buyer") and is entered on this date:

Seller's Responsibility:

- 1 The seller guarantees that the puppy is in good health (minus potential intestinal parasites) and has received the following:
 - A: Age-appropriate immunizations
 - B: Microchip
 - C: Deworming
 - D: Health Certificate
 - E: Chiropractic Adjustment

2 The seller provides warranty against debilitating congenital defects for a period of 2 years as outlined in health warranty.

- A: Seller guarantees all possible steps have been taken with sire/dam selection and breeding to prevent hereditary issues
- B: Debilitating congenital defects are defined as those present since birth that are either lifethreatening or would prevent the puppy from fulfilling the intended purpose for which it was purchased.
- C: Any suspected debilitating congenital defect must be confirmed by a licensed veterinarian (including necropsy if patient dies).
 - i Buyer must supply any requested veterinary records related to the condition to the seller. I. Seller has the right to require a second opinion at vet or specialist of sellers choice at sellers expense.
- D: If congenital defect is identified within warranty period the buyer has the option to obtain a replacement puppy of equal or lesser value form the future litter of their choosing, or a refund of the puppy up to the purchase price.
 - i. Original puppy does not need to be returned provided there is proper documentation of congenital issue.
 ii. Replacement puppy could be a wait up to - months.
 iii. Color or gender is not guaranteed.
 iv. Shipping fees will not be refunded and any shipping costs for replacement puppy are the responsibility of the buyer.
- E: If the puppy is euthanized or in any was disposed of, without a second opinion from the seller's

vet, the buyer waives all rights to a replacement puppy.

- F: This warranty does NOT include viral illness, hernias, hypoglycemia, parasites, cancer or endocrine disorders. It also does not include any illness due to the ingestions of foreign objects, food, chemicals or physical injury.
- G: No warranties or guarantees, expressed or implied are made under this contract except as stated
- H: This warranty in non-transferable.
- 3 It is to be clearly understood, that the breeder does NOT, under any circumstances, accept responsibility for any vet and/or health care expense.

Buyer's Responsibility:

- 1 The buyer agrees to pay seller a total sum of \$ _____. This fee does not include shipping or transportation.
- 2 The buyer bears all costs relating to the sales of the above animal, including transportation. The risk of loss or injury to the above animal is on the buyer at all times after the puppy leaves the seller.
- 3 The buyer agrees to have the puppy examined by a licensed vet within 3 business days of taking possession.
 - A: If the puppy is found to be in poor health, the buyer has the option of returning the puppy to the seller, at buyers cost, for a full refund.
 - B: The buyer will provide a written statement from licensed vet within the 3 business days clearly stating defect or illness
 - C: If the puppy is not taken to the vet within the 3 business days, buyer agrees that puppy is in perfect health.
 - D: Please ensure that the puppy is kept in a kennel, or held in the waiting room to a vet office, and that the exam room is properly disinfected before appointment.
 - E: 4 off the floor. Ensure your puppy paws to not come into contact with any potential surfaces of risk at any public settings.
- 4 The buyer is responsible for all medical expenses associated with the treatment of intestinal parasites if puppy is diagnosed with them (even if puppy has parasites present when sent home).
 - A: You must be willing to treat puppy parasites, sometimes more than 1 treatment is needed
 - B: It is common for parasites to flourish after the stress of joining their new family.
 - C: Most parasites can be contagious and it is possible that other dogs in the house can get them.
- 5 The buyer agrees to provide the best possible care for their puppy. This includes, but not limited to:
 - A: Housing the puppy indoors. Poodles and Doodles do not grow an undercoat.
 - B: Feeding only a quality complete food intended for dogs.
 - C: Maintaining their puppy at a healthy weight4
 - D: Having their dog examined by a licensed vet annually
 - E: Keeping all immunizations current according to the guideline of the American Veterinary Medical Association
 - F: Administering heartworm preventative medication)If living in an area of concern)
 - G: Registration of microchip
- 6 The buyer agrees to postpone strenuous forced exercise until after the puppy is over 1 year of age. (80% of hip dysplasia is caused by improper exercise.
- 7 The buyer agrees to contact seller immediately if the buyer determines they are unable to keep their puppy for any reason. The buyer and seller will determine how the dog will be rehomed.
- 8 The buyer agrees to NEVER place their puppy with a rescue group, in a shelter, pound, or similar facility or research lab.

Spay and Neuter Contract:

- 1 Spaying/neutering/gonag sparing surgery (GGS) by a licensed, reputable vet is required on the above puppy prior to 18 months of age, but not before a females first heat or 6 months of age.
- 2 It is understood that at the time of sale that this puppy is not to be used for breeding and is being sold as a pet or

companion without breeding rights.

3 Seller agrees to reimburse buyer \$250.00 within 30 days of proof of spay/neuter from licensed vet.
