Shima KOBAYASHI Chromatic Harmonica

In 1995 Shima won the World Harmonica Championships. From 1996-97 she studied with Tommy Reilly in the UK under the Japanese Government Overseas Study Programme for Artists. In addition to performing works for harmonica, she is involved in creative activities such as collaboration with contemporary composers, improvisation and also writing music that involves storytelling. Yumi WATANABE Piano

Graduated and completed her postgraduate studies at Musashino Academia Musicae. She has given solo recitals in Tokyo and Osaka since 1994. From 2004-2007 she was a visiting lecturer at the Music Department of the Special Needs Education School for the Visually Impaired, University of Tsukuba. Yumi has performed with artists active in different genres including Keiki Midorikawa, Yuriko Mukoujima and Keisuke Ota. She is a pianist for the marimba ensemble Mori and instructor at the Seishin Nursery.

Starred in NHK-TV's 'Dream Island Girl', 'Four Seasons-Utopiano/A Dream in a Different Key' (1980) [Italian Broadcasting Institute Award, TV Grand Prize for New Actress]. She played the leading role of the piano tuner 'A' in the NHK-TV productions 'River Trilogy', including 'The Flows of a River, the Sound of a Violin'. The radio drama '夜明けのショパン-甦る天才ピアニスト田中希代子' (Chopin at Dawn - The Revival of the Genius Pianist Kiyoko Tanaka -TBS Radio 1989) [Hoso Bunka Foundation Award], 'DQ' (NHK-FM 1992) [Galaxy Award]. Since 1989, she has performed in recitation events. In 2021, she played the voice of Ms Hatanaka in Mamoru Hosoda's 'Belle' (The Dragon and the Freckled Princess).
