# **Advanced Level Syllabus Overview**

**Student Level at Part 1** – very fluent but doesn't always understand shades of meaning in complex situations.

#### Course aims:

- To correct remaining small mistakes in student's use, understanding and pronunciation of language.
- To introduce student to more colloquial language such as idioms, figures of speech and when to use them.

#### **Course includes:**

**Please note** - Extra revision lessons and re-sit tests are available. Students who wish to progress to the next level (and receive the certificate), must pass the end of course test. Students who do not pass the test first time can re-sit as many times as they like.

# By the end of Part 1, the student should:

- 1. Be able to differentiate between types of language and use it appropriately.
- 2. Be able to use and understand both receptive and productive language even if with a little hesitation.

### HALF-WAY THROUGH ADVANCED LEVEL

Student Level at Part 2 – fluent to the level similar to that of a native.

#### Course aims:

- To practice their receptive and productive use of the language in a variety of different contexts.
- To sort out any remaining misunderstandings or loose ends.

### **Lesson Structure**

Lesson length: 1 hour

- 1. Homework feedback (15 mins.)
- **2. Speaking** (20 mins approx.)
- 3. **Listening** (20 mins approx. including marking time.)
- **4.** Homework explanation **reading** and **writing** exercise (5 mins approx.)

#### Note:

- The above structure is a general guide but if a student needs more time to
  practice a specific skill, then the structure can be flexible. The lessons at this level
  are designed to help a student who is basically fluent in English but who wants to
  polish their English language skills and use colloquial language that is not used
  every day.
- The aim of each lesson is that the student is able to recognise and use the new target language with confidence.
- Part 2 is a repetition of Part 1 but at a *higher level*. This is because the purpose of Part 2 is to reinforce the language learnt at Part 1 but at a higher level.
