Upper-Intermediate Level Syllabus Overview

Student Level at Part 1 – student can talk fairly fluently with the ability to talk about things from different perspectives but not in huge depth.

Course aims:

- To become more familiar and fluent at using language previously taught.
- To learn more advanced grammatical structures and ways of speaking and be able to recognise them.
- To learn more advanced vocabulary and concepts.
- Introduce student to more complicated areas of the English language and how to use it.

Please note - Extra revision lessons and re-sit tests are available. Students who wish to progress to the next level (and receive the certificate), must pass the end of course test. Students who do not pass the test first time can re-sit as many times as they like.

By the end of Part 1, the student should:

1. Be familiar with all areas of the English language that require a person to be fluent.
2. Be using and understanding English much more fluently and in different styles.
3. Have a better idea of and when different types and forms of language are used.

HALF-WAY THROUGH UPPER-INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

Student Level at Part 2 – student can talk much more fluently and in much more depth.

Course aims:

- To be considerably more fluent and be able to communicate without much hesitation both receptively and productively.
- To practice using all the language (especially that just learnt) until they are using their skills in a way that is heading towards second nature.
- The language that is covered at this level of the course will be largely based on the student's individual strengths and weaknesses, preferences, and requirements.

By the end of this course, student should:

1. Be receiving and producing language very easily without much hesitation and be pretty fluent.
2. Be ready to learn parts of language that are not used every day or even by every native English speaker.

END OF UPPER-INTERMEDIATE LEVEL

Lesson Structure

Lesson length: 1 hour

1. Homework feedback (15 mins approx.)
2. **Speaking** (new target language) (20 mins approx.)
3. **Listening** (new target language) (20 mins approx. including marking time.)
4. Homework explanation (5 mins approx.) Homework is a **reading** and **writing** exercise.

Note:

- The above structure is a general guide but if a student needs more time to practice a specific skill, then the structure can be flexible. The lessons at this level are designed to help a student, whose level is almost fluent, to develop their language.
- The aim of each lesson and homework is that the student uses each skill to practice the new target language while reinforcing language learnt from the previous level.
- Part 2 is a repetition of Part 1 but at a *higher level*. This is because the purpose of Part 2 is to reinforce the language learnt at Part 1 *but at a higher level*.
