HOUSEHOLD CHEMICAL COLLECTION EVENT

Carbondale, IL– A one-day household chemical collection will be held at the Banterra Center (former SIU Arena), south parking lot on Saturday, June 7, 2025. Illinois residents can safely drop-off waste at the site from 8am – 3pm by appointment only.

Items to be accepted at the collection include: paint thinner, aerosols, household cleaners, pesticides, insecticides, herbicides, automotive fluids -such as antifreeze, motor oil, old gasoline, rechargeable batteries, solvents, polishes, pool chemicals, lawn chemicals, oil-based paints, e-cigarettes/vapes, propane and helium tanks and Mapp-gas cylinders. Mercury-containing devices, such as thermometers, thermostats and fluorescent and CFL bulbs are also being accepted.

Items which will absolutely **NOT** be accepted at the collection include: latex paint, explosives, ammunition, fireworks, fire extinguishers, smoke detectors, farm machinery oil, medical waste, electronics, alkaline & lead-acid batteries, appliances, tires, and radioactive material, syringes, needles and medical waste. Eligible participants wishing to dispose of materials in containers larger than five gallons must contact Jackson County Health Dept. prior to the event.
