Careers in Public Health

- What kind of degree do you need to work in Public Health?
 - Medical field (LPN, RN, BSN, mid-level practitioner, MD)
 - Science field (environmental health, biology, epidemiology, food science)
 - Education (community health, health education)
 - Social science (social welfare)

Degrees in Public Health

- Master of Public Health (MPH)
 - Primary professional degree in Public Health
 - Provides general public health knowledge with specialization
- Master of Science in Public Health
 - Prepares practitioner in one specific aspect of public health rather than a more general focus
- Doctoral
 - Highest academic degree
 - Prepares professionals for teaching as college faculty members or research centers
