POLLEN AVOIDANCE MEASURES

- There is no way to completely avoid pollens
- During peak pollen counts keep the windows of the home and car closed
- If air conditioning is available it can be helpful
- If a clothes dryer is available it is preferable to drying clothes outside
- Avoid play outside during peak hours (morning)
- Avoid cutting the grass or doing work in the yard
