On arriving at the office, you can expect to:

- Speak with the Allergist about your concerns
- Undergo testing (such as skin prick testing) if indicated

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Please bring all your child's medications to the appointment
- Do not use antihistamines, cold medications or Gravol for 5 days beforehand (you can continue to use nasal sprays, inhalers and pain medications)
- Please ensure the child is accompanied by a caregiver who knows the medical history in detail
- Estimated appointment length is 1-2 hours

FOLLOW UP APPOINTMENT

On arriving at the office, you can expect to:

- Speak with the Allergist about your concerns
- Undergo testing (such as skin prick testing) if indicated

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Please bring all your child's medications to the appointment
- Do not use antihistamines, cold medications or Gravol for 5 days beforehand (you can continue to use nasal sprays, inhalers and pain medications)
