# JON SHARP



What a difference a few weeks make - second in the league to second bottom. Even allowing for the fact that it is still early season, there is no excuse for that and we must improve.

We have planned to play an exciting game this season as we develop a largely young new squad, and we are successfully working ourselves into attacking positions but then we are too frequently coughing up possession to the opposition who is able to run it back against a misaligned defence and go three-quarters the length of the pitch, usually for a seven-pointer: this happened three times last week and five times the week before. This has produced final scorelines that do not truly reflect the run of play although those tries alone would not have changed the final results. Improvement of handling and ball retention is now an urgent focus.

Off the pitch, last week we took a significant step towards our future aspirations. We signed the 'umbrella' contract for the re-development of Butts Park Arena with an experienced development team who are carrying out other major projects in the City, and in support of this, project managers, architects, engineers and facility operators have also been designated to the project.

There is still much work to be done in terms of detailed design and planning before we can put a spade in the ground,

which we hope to do at the end of this season. The end goal is much improved spectator facilities combined with non-rugby facilities designed to provide much needed income to the club, all well in time for our 150th anniversary year.

This is a very significant step for the club and for the regeneration of Spon End and therefore our city. A more detailed press release will be issued in the coming weeks.

But, back to the here and now, we need a morale boosting win to set our season back on track. Your vociferous support is never more needed.

Welcome back to the butts Park Arena!

The squad are well aware that the last few weeks of results have not been what we are looking for and we all feel disappointed that the scoreboard has not reflected the effort from the team or the potential of the squad overall. Today will be a tough challenge against Nottingham, who have developed significantly since our pre-season game in the Summer.

Last week against Pirates, we were always in the battle, and we created a lot of scoring opportunities but didn't look after the ball and too often chose the wrong option when close to their line. The pathway really is working well, and the U19s had their fourth BUCS game of the season against Oxford Brookes Uni on Wednesday, winning 40-0. They are yet to concede a point this season, but have the tougher challenge of Loughborough Uni away next Wednesday.

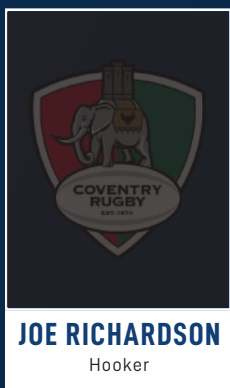

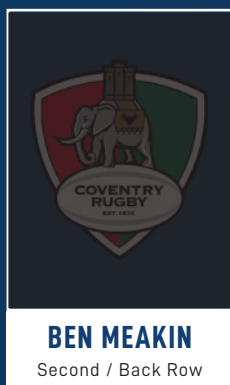
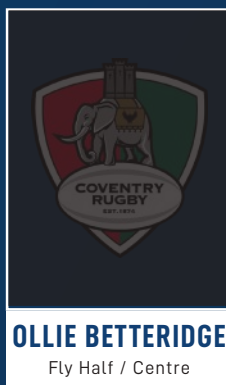

# TODAY'S OPPONENTS

**Fixtures between Coventry & Nottingham go back a very long way, 130 years to be precise, when in the old Midland Counties Cup, Cov won 25 pts -nil at the old Butts.**

A sequence, which save for the two world war years & a 9 year period immediately afterwards, has largely continued unbroken.

League Rugby of course goes back to the start of the 1987/88 season & for the 23rd meeting since then in the league format, we extend a very warm welcome to the Nottingham squad, coaches, management & supporters.

One feels there is little relevance this afternoon in the little fact that, preseason, we defeated the Green & Whites 60 pts -10 here. Being preseason, it is a result which does not count in our overall record or player statistics. In any case, much has happened since that day in early September. Of those 23 league encounters to date, Nottingham lead 12-10 in victories, with one match at Lady Bay two seasons ago ending as a draw.

Nottingham won the first league game between us back all those 34 years ago, Cov having to wait a further 9 years before recording our first, a game which still features in the memory of those who witnessed it. 102-22, with 13 tries,

still stands as our biggest league win overall.

Last season, with just the one game, Cov Rugby won at Lady Bay, before the season was cut short.

Nottingham, having had a blank week last weekend, currently lie in 9th place, one above us, but now having played four games to Cov's five. Two wins at home, coupled with two defeats on their travels at Richmond & Cornish Pirates, where the margin was 8pts -32. Any interesting parallel or comparison there ? Draw your own conclusions on that one !



Craig Hammond, a former popular Club Captain, returned to Nottingham for the start of this season, replacing another club stalwart in Neil Fowkes as Head Coach.

There are in the current Green & Whites squad, two players with either a direct link to Cov Rugby or the city itself.

Fly Half Sam Holdsworth played his early rugby at the Broadstreet

Club, before moving on to Birmingham Moseley & Rotherham Titans, before leaving for Nottingham.

The second of the two is hooker Jake Farnworth, who made 13 appearances in our Blue & Shirt jersey between 2014-2016, whilst dual registered from Leicester Tigers.

We fully expect this afternoon's encounter to be another close, hard fought one. Nottingham seeking their first away win of the season. Whilst for Cov Rugby, after three consecutive defeats, an opportunity for the squad, which has been hard hit by injuries, to hit back on home soil. All that before we have a three week league break.

Next Saturday, in the first of those three weeks, Rams from Reading, & pushing hard for promotion from National League One, are the visitors here for a club friendly, kick off 3.00pm. For those not too familiar with their name, Rams, a proud community club, were originally Old Redingensians, before the RFU gave permission for a name change three years ago.

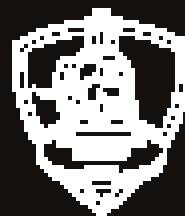
