



TODAY'S OPPONENTS

Boxing Day matches at the Butts Park have become something of an endangered article in recent times, so it is particularly pleasing to be able reverse that trend this afternoon.

In doing so, a warm welcome to the Ampthill squad, coaches, committee & supporters.

The earlier meeting at Dillingham Park brought about an away defeat, which sadly has become something of a trend this season. 7 penalty goals landed by fly half Russell Bennett made us pay, so with that factor alone in mind, there must be large amounts of motivation for the Cov squad to build upon this afternoon as they return after two successive matches away.

Fixtures between us are relatively new, the first being just six seasons ago in 2015/16. Whilst there have been two meetings in the Championship Cup which saw the home club succeed on both occasions, this festive clash is just the 10th overall in either National League One or more recently, the Greene King IPA Championship. The Ampthill win we referred to earlier brought the winning tally to 5-4 in their favour, as our Bedfordshire visitors seek their first win here at the BPA. Under Director of Rugby Mark Lavery & the highly experienced Head Coach Paul Turner, Ampthill currently lie in 7th place & 3 points above us, so a bonus point win today would create a change there.

Last weekend on their home turf, Ampthill edged out Nottingham Rugby, a late try from centre three quarter Ben Cambriani sealing a 20 points -15 win. Two of their four wins have been achieved on their travels, both at the Athletic ground v London Scottish & more recently Richmond at the end of November; the latter by 38-36 in a 74 points thriller. Prior to last Saturday, three



games had been lost in succession.

There is just one member of the current Ampthill squad with a sort of link here to the BPA. Centre/full back Tom Hudson was here very briefly last season whilst on his way from Gloucester.

Cov's biggest win in this fixture came four seasons ago in 2017/18 by 63 points -14, whilst last season the margin in our favour was 26 pts -15, prior to the Pandemic cutting short the season.

Looking at the current situation, with our away form overall being disappointing, there is the situation here today for the squad, with home backing, to come good & finish 2021 on a high. The " Cov Dog", so evident in the comeback at Jersey two weeks ago, is certainly due to roar again, backed by that home support.

Meantime this being our final game here of the calendar year, your scribe would like to wish everyone, whatever colours you support, every good wish for 2022. Who knows what it will bring in this current difficult world we are living in, but let us be really positive & hopefully the good times will roll.

Hooker Billy Harding, 28 (1.80m, 100kg) adds some Championship experience to the Ampthill pack for the 2021-22 season - he made 31 appearances for London Scottish between 2018 and 2020 scoring 4 tries. Billy learnt to play the game with Scottish Juniors and Colts but made his senior rugby debut as a Hooker in New Zealand where he spent a year before returning to the UK with Stourbridge in National Two South and then joining Esher in National One.

Tom made his Ampthill debut last March in a narrow defeat to Doncaster Knights, and went on to make 7 appearances scoring two tries, including a fine individual effort against old club Hartpury at Dillingham Park in the short 2021 season. Tom has moved to his preferred Centre position this season where he has formed a consistent partnership with Ben Cambriani.
