

Cambodian Student Association Constitution

ARTICLE I. NAME OF STUDENT ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be called Cambodian Student Association at UCSD.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

We, the Cambodian Student Association (CSA) believe that by (1) building and strengthening identification of the Cambodian culture among fellow members, students and community at large, (2) offering consistent academic, social and moral encouragement through activities and community service and (3) developing social networks that will assist us during our time in college and in our lives thereafter, we will have established rare relationships and support systems based on common principles and values with fellow members who share common interests.

ARTICLE III. NONPROFIT STATEMENT

The Cambodian Student Association at UCSD is a non-profit student organization.

ARTICLE V. FREQUENCY OF ORGANIZATION MEETINGS

There are no official rules to be a member of the club, nor are there any fees required for membership. Our organization hosts four general body meetings per quarter that members are not required to attend but are encouraged to in order to interact with other members.

ARTICLE VI. QUALIFICATIONS FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND METHODS OF SELECTING AND REPLACING OFFICERS

Only registered UCSD students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UCSD students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

There are typically 7-8 officers depending on the organization's needs. These officers include the president(s), vice president, secretary, treasurer, cultural coordinator, outreach coordinator(s), and historian. The officers will constitute an executive committee. Members who wish to become an officer complete an application process and are chosen by the existing officer board. New officers are chosen at the end of the school year in May. Anyone UCSD student who has attended a general body meeting or event, can be eligible for office. New officers assume their position before the new fall quarter. Officers are replaced/removed through a voting process with each officer voting, with the exception of presidents having a 50% +1 vote, to ensure a determining vote.

ARTICLE VII. RISK MANAGEMENT

The Cambodian Student Association at UCSD is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself. The Cambodian Student Association at UCSD understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.
