

ARTICLE I. NAME OF STUDENT ORGANIZATION

The organization shall be called Bangali Student Association.

ARTICLE II. STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The establishment of the Bangali Student Association at UCSD is an effort to:

1. recognize and support UCSD students that identify with the Bangali identity
2. provide a space for open dialogue of prevalent issues in the Bangali community and create a brave space to express points of view
3. explore the Bangali identity and promote cultural ties and wellbeing

ARTICLE III. NONPROFIT STATEMENT

Bangali Student Association is a non-profit student organization.

ARTICLE IV. REQUIREMENTS FOR MEMBERSHIP

There are no dues required for membership.

Active membership is granted to students who attend at least 2 events hosted by the organization per quarter. Active membership can be renewed or canceled each quarter.

All University of California, San Diego undergraduate students are eligible for membership fo Bangali Student Association regardless of race, religion, sex, sexual orientation, gender identity, nationality, citizenship status, disability, age, political views, or any other unlisted and protected factors.

ARTICLE V. FREQUENCY OF ORGANIZATION MEETINGS

Bangali Student Association will hold General Body Meetings (GBM), fundraisers, special events, board meetings, and sub-committees. Times and locations of GBM meetings will be decided before the start of each quarter based on board and member availability. All meeting information will be distributed through email and social media platforms.

ARTICLE VI. QUALIFICATIONS FOR HOLDING OFFICE AND METHODS OF SELECTING AND REPLACING OFFICERS

Only registered UCSD students may hold office in the organization. Only registered UCSD students may vote in elections for the selection of the organization's officers.

The officers for this organization include: 2 Co-Presidents, Vice President, Financial Chair, and Community Outreach Chair. They will also be principal members. Their duties are as follows:

- Co-Presidents (2): run general meetings, communicate with University staff, plan organization events
- Vice President: fill in for President when absent, set time and dates for meetings, take notes for meetings, assist with organizing events
- Financial Chair: take care of all funds, manage fundraising events
- Community Outreach Chair: publicize organization events to students, manage social media accounts, advertising organization to recruit more students
- Event Planning Chair: for detailed plans of events, work with presidents and VP to create content, propose ideas, and communicate with UCSD to confirm each event meets qualifications.

Executive committee will be constituted of the 2 Co-Presidents, Vice President, Financial Chair, Community Outreach Chair, and Event Planning Chair.

Executive committee officers will be selected via an application and/or interview process, conducted by the Co-Presidents and Vice President. Applications will be available in the Spring Quarter of each academic year and each position is held from the following Summer to Spring Quarter of the following school year.*

Officers can be removed by filling out complaint forms that the executive committee (minus the person in question) will look through and formally remove the officer from their position. Officers can be replaced by doing another voting process for the position.

* Exception for 2020-2021 school year: The positions will be held from Spring quarter to the Spring Quarter of the following year.

ARTICLE VII. RISK MANAGEMENT

Bangali Student Association at UCSD is a registered student organization at the University of California, San Diego, but not part of the University itself.

Bangali Student Association at UCSD understands that the University does not assume legal liability for the actions of the organization.

There are no outstanding risks associated with this organization.
