<u>Treasurers Report:</u> Kathie presented the current Treasurer's report (May-July 2018), with a verbal update of Aug. expenditures and income A motion was made by Dale Duquet and seconded by Justine Gallagher to accept the Treasurer's report. The motion passed.

Current approximate balances are:

• General Fund: \$21,800 (\$16,000 through August)

LMP Fund: \$84,200Dam Maint Fund: \$32,500

2018 WVPOAC Raffle: To date, 373 tickets have been sold/collected + 10 incentive. (2017 raffle total tickets was 280 sold.)

Committee Reports:

Membership: 2019 dues are to remain the same as previous years at \$75.00. Kathie reported that we have eighty-eight (88) paid members YTD for 2018. WVPOAC membership totals from previous years were 95 in 2017, 89 in 2016, 81 in 2015, 89 in 2014; 87 in 2013, and 77 in 2012.

Social Activities/Events:

- **Pontoon Poker Run**: Event was held on Aug. 11th, coordinated by Ernie Zack and Millie Mann; event had 41 participants and generated \$1,000 for the Association.
- **Boat Parade:** Event was held on July 7th, coordinator by Joyce Spoolstra; six (6) pontoons participated.

- Clubhouse Grass Maintenance: Dave Andrusiak will coordinate once again in 2019, and thanked all who volunteered in 2018. Volunteers are needed for grass cutting in 2019, so please contact Dave for scheduling. As in the past, this works best if we can have two individuals per cut---one using a riding mower and the other using a push mower. Thanks Dave for coordinating once again!!!
- **Hayride:** The 2018 event date is Saturday, Oct. 13th, starting at 1:30PM at the Association clubhouse; coordinator is Blair Wickman---volunteers needed!!!
