

### **1913 - Advertisement**

*"The Landlords' Game" is published at the nominal price one shilling, and all land taxers should make a point of obtaining the game. Application should be sent to Miss Clarke, Newbie, Annan."*

Annan is a Scottish town, close to the English frontier and situated along the north side of the Solway Firth bay.

This is where the Landlord's game first arrived outside the United States. The same year the game made its way to London, England.

It was published under the name, "Brer Fox an' Brer Rabbit." by Newbie Games Co. While the game says it was patented, a search of libraries shows no such patent in 1913.
