

Bird Feeder

1-liter or 2-liter soda bottle w/ top

12" of String (to hang feeder)

¼" dowel rod about 10" long (for perch)

Birdseed

- 1- Parents cut two 2" to 3" holes in the soda bottle directly across from each other about 4" from the bottom of the bottle.
- 2- With a hole puncher, punch out a hole 1" directly beneath each large hole.
- 3- Insert the dowel rod through both of the small holes, creating a perch for the birds while feeding.
- 4- Poke 2 holes across from each other close to the top of the bottle. (below the lid)
- 5- Fill with about 3" of bird seed.
- 6- Hang on a limb that is easily observable from inside.
- 7- Watch with your child at different times during the day for birds to come and eat.
- 8- On a piece of paper, help your child tally/record the different kinds of birds you observe.
