Steven has been music editing for over twenty years with a Golden Reel award and seven Golden Reel nominations. With over ninety films to his credit, some recent feature film work includes: *After*,

Mary (with Gary Oldman), The Package, 24 Hours To Live (with Ethan Hawke),
The Revenant (with Leonardo DiCaprio), and Tides Of Fate, a David Ellison
documentary to name a few. He has worked with many composers, including,
Pinar Toprak, Tyler Bates, Klaus Badelt, Mark Mothersbaugh, and Nathan Furst.

Saltzman has recently published the only current book on music editing:

He enjoys teaching music editing and post production audio for composers as well as lecturing at various institutions and venues internationally and domestically, including UCLA Extension, California State University, USC, and Chapman University.
