Scripture

Jude 24-25:

"Now unto him that is able to keep you from falling, and to present you faultless before the presence of his glory with exceeding joy, To the only wise God our Saviour, be glory and majesty, dominion and power, both now and ever. Amen."

Other Doxologies in the Bible:

For God the Father

1 Chronicles 29:10-13

"Wherefore David blessed the LORD before all the congregation: and David said, Blessed be thou, LORD God of Israel our father, for ever and ever. Thine, O LORD, is the greatness, and the power, and the glory, and the victory, and the majesty: for all that is in the heaven and in the earth is thine; thine is the kingdom, O LORD, and thou art exalted as head above all. Both riches and honour come of thee, and thou reignest over all; and in thine hand is power and might; and in thine hand it is to make great, and to give strength unto all. Now therefore, our God, we thank thee, and praise thy glorious name."

For Jesus, the Son

1 Timothy 3:16

"And without controversy great is the mystery of godliness: God was manifest in the flesh, justified in the Spirit, seen of angels, preached unto the Gentiles, believed on in the world, received up into glory."

Jude writes:

Jesus is "able to keep you from falling" -> meaning that you would not fall into the false teacher's web of lies

Jesus will "present you faultless" before God the Father

Philippians 1:6 -> "He who began a good work in you, will perfect it until the day of Christ Jesus"

"to the only wise God" -> God is the only true god -> there are a lot of lowercase-g gods.

To "our Saviour" we ascribe glory and majesty – in contrast to the false teachers who revile God's majesty

He is the only one with true, eternal dominion and ultimate power
