Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

Romans 1:1-7,16-25

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we'll take a look at how Paul shared the gospel and encouraged others to share God's message boldly. We'll also see that only God is worthy of our worship and what happens when we turn our worship to other things. These are the main points:

- Believers are called (Romans 1:1-7).
- Believers are unashamed of the gospel (Romans 1:16-17).
- Believers are worshipers of God alone (Romans 1:18-25).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- What has our family been "set apart for" (v. 1) and "called by Jesus" (v. 6) to do?
- When are we tempted to be ashamed of the gospel, or hide the truth of what we believe to avoid ridicule or contempt? Explain.
- How can we see God when we look at creation? How can this point our family to worship God?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Sit together and create a family calendar for the week, filling in every member's schedule. Then look at how you spend the majority of your time as a family. Where we devote our time points to where our hearts are aligned. In other words, we'll give the most time to what we love the most. Look at your schedule again. How can you prioritize time with or give more time to God?
