Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

Acts 9:1-20

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we'll read about Saul's conversion—how he went from persecuting people who loved Jesus to following Jesus himself. Here are the main ideas:

- Saul experiences mercy from the Lord (Acts 9:1-9).
- Saul receives a mission from the Lord (Acts 9:10-16).
- Saul proclaims the name of the Lord (Acts 9:17-20).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- Why is it sometimes difficult for our family to think about how what we do to other believers, we're really doing to Jesus? How might this shift our actions and attitudes toward them?
- When has God called our family to do something but we felt resistant? How can we commit to being obedient like Ananias instead?
- What is God calling our family to do now? What steps can we take to be obedient to His call?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Sometimes we tend to think God can't use us because of something we've done in the past. Invite each family member to consider and share how their stories could be part of God's story. In other words, share how that thing from your past could actually provide unique opportunities or ways for you to share the gospel.
