Use the following thoughts and questions to have a spiritual conversation as a family. Don't emphasize having the right answer, but focus on spending time discussing the Word as a family.

SCRIPTURE

1 Corinthians 1:10-25; 1 Corinthians 12:12-18

SESSION SUMMARY

In this week's session, we'll look at how the gospel unites all believers, the church. Part of following Jesus means pursuing unity with other believers so we can honor Him, encourage each other, and be a light to those around us. Here are the main ideas:

- The church is united under one leader (1 Corinthians 1:10-17).
- The church is united by one gospel (1 Corinthians 1:18-25).
- The church is united in one body (1 Corinthians 12:12-18).

CONVERSATION QUESTIONS

- When is it difficult for our family to be united? How can we pursue unity in those situations in the future?
- How have we seen others become divided over which Christian leaders to follow? Why is it important that we remember it's about Jesus, not His followers?
- Why is it sometimes easy to be jealous of certain people's roles or gifts within the church? How can we help each other embrace the roles and gifts God has given us?

FAMILY CHALLENGE

Invite each person to share his or her favorite inspirational quote. Discuss each one, holding it up against what God's Word says. Would it be considered worldly wisdom or godly wisdom? Then, search for a verse or passage in Proverbs that communicates a similar idea or theme but in a godly way. Talk about ways you can continually pursue godly wisdom.
