Sec. 12-81. Foul water prohibited and declared a nuisance.

It shall be unlawful and is declared a nuisance for any person to allow the accumulation of stagnant or foul water in any natural or man-made pond or lake on any property owned, occupied or under said person's control.

Sec. 12-82. Exceptions.

The following are exempted from the stagnant, but not foul water, requirements of section 12-61:

(1)

Ponds or lakes that are one-half acre or more in size;

(2)

Ponds or lakes that are stocked with fish; and

(3)

Ponds or lakes that are aerated by some mechanical means.

Sec. 12-83. Swimming pools or hot tubs.

It shall be unlawful, between the 15th day of April and the 15th day of November each year, for any person to allow water to remain in a swimming pool or hot tub on premises owned, occupied or controlled by said person, unless such water is circulating through an operational filtration system and chlorine or another similar chemical treatment has been applied to the water.
