

Last year we had 150 members out of a total of 796 homes. Our goal is 200 this year. We need your


participation. We also need volunteers for block captains and committee members. A willingness to serve and a few hours of your time could make a big difference in Woodmere. Let's all pull together.



I've searched and asked And wondered so, Where it came from... Guess I'll never know.



Good News for Woodmere Park

The Parks Committee recently met with Russell Stringer (Urban Forester with the City of Montgomery) to discuss a master plan to completely shade the walking trail in the east side of the park and to put shade trees along Woodmere Boulevard between the east and south ends of the park. Mr. Russell provided the committee with maps that show how the plan can be implemented in several stages. The city will plant the trees, but the neighborhood must provide the trees. Trees cost an average of \$120 each. Through grants from organizations like the Alabama Power Foundation and from continued support from our city council, we feel certain that this plan can become a reality over a period of time. When completed this will greatly enhance our park and our neighborhood.



We are also planning improvements to the berms along Carmichael Road and Woodmere Drive. Considerable trimming and mulching are needed in those areas. The Parks Committee and the Long Range Task Force will be working together on this project.
