

Sec. 27-385. - All-night parking.

(a)

No person, except physicians on emergency calls, shall park a vehicle on any street in the central business district for a period of time longer than one hour between the hours of 2:00 a.m. and 5:00 a.m. of any day.

(b)

It shall be unlawful for any person to park a trailer or any vehicle, as specified in subsection (c) of this section, on any street within a residential section in the city if such person is not engaged in the continual act of making a delivery, or loading or providing a service, unless such person first obtains a permit from the chief of police. The city police department is hereby authorized to remove such a trailer or vehicle to the nearest garage designated or maintained by the police department, or otherwise maintained by this city, when the trailer or vehicle is left unattended, and such person is not engaged in the continual act of making a delivery, or loading or providing a service. Upon removal of such trailer or vehicle, an officer shall notify the owner of such trailer or vehicle as provided in Code of Ala. 1975, § 32-13-1. Disposition of such trailer or vehicle shall be made as provided by [section 27-13](#) of this Code.

(c)

This section shall apply to all buses, trailers, both passenger and commercial, house or camping trailers, mobile homes, and to all motor vehicles which, when regularly operated in this state, are required to carry truck tags, excepting therefrom, station wagons, and small trucks which are not larger than passenger automobiles.
