Other Programs

Practice Players:

- We do offer practice player positions to select athletes.
- Practice Player positions allow for players to practice with our teams, but they will not be on the regular tournament roster.
- If a team is missing players for a specific tournament, practice players may be asked to sub.
- Practice player positions are not meant to be a consolation prize. They are meant to be an indication that while the player receiving the offer might not play the position needed by the team, they are still considered a strong player in the eyes of the program with skills that are deserving of additional attention and development.

Skills Academy:

- This program focuses on skill development for Middle and Elementary School aged players who are not already on an SAVB roster.
- We try to hold at least 1 Skill Building Series during each travel season.
- Season 11 Skills Academy dates, times, and locations are TBD.

Tryouts/Registration

To register for tryouts, please head over to our website (https://sportingalbanyvolleyball.com/club-tryouts/) and click on the "Sign Up Here" button to access the Google Form.

Tryout Requirements:

- 1. **Active USA Volleyball Membership attained through SportsEngine**. For tryouts, the "Tryout" or "Single Event" membership will suffice. Proof of membership physical or digital needs to be presented at tryouts. **MEMBERSHIPS FROM THE 2023-2024 SEASON ARE STILL ACTIVE!!!!**
- 2. **One-time \$25 SAVB Tryout fee.** Must be submitted before or at check-in of the player's first tryout date. Can be cash, check (made out to "Sporting Albany Volleyball") or Venmo club director Zack Kuhn (@SportingZK).
- 3. Completed USAV Medical Release Form. Found on our website.
- * Please make an effort to attend AT LEAST ONE tryout date (preferably both). You are eligible for position offers by attending at least one day. If you cannot make either tryout date, please contact us.
- ** We may hold make-up tryouts for our Boys 15u-18u teams and our Girls 14u-18u teams in September if necessary. This will be determined after the end of our August tryouts.
- *** Attending tryouts and/or having previously played for SAVB does NOT guarantee you the position you previously held. Every year SAVB coaches do their best to evaluate and re-evaluate players when offering tournament player positions and practice player positions.

How will I know if I have made a team?

Within a week of finishing tryouts, we will send out position offers via email or phone call.

As per our USAV Region's Policies, each player will have 14 days to accept their offer before it is vacated. Players can accept/decline offers as soon as they wish, but after 14 days the position will automatically be vacated.

Once you accept an offer, you will receive directions via SportsEngine to link your account to Sporting Albany Volleyball Club.

^{*} Rosters will be selected based on skill level and age. We will always first consider the youngest age level an athlete is eligible for. Then we will look at "moving up" players based on skill level and positions played.

Practices

- 1. Sporting Albany's teams will practice from **Thanksgiving until Memorial Day.**
- 2. Each team is guaranteed a minimum of 40 practices.
- 3. We aim to have 2 practices per week.
 - a. What happens if practice gets cancelled?? We construct our season's practice schedule similar to local school districts where there are built-in snow days. We will always make up practices to the best of our ability, but may not NEED to if a team is on track to hit their minimum number of practices.
 - b. Depending on the practice facility, we may be able to schedule a make up practice for the same week. If not, we may move to a different practice location, or wait until the month of May to make up missed practices.
- 4. Our practice facilities will include:
 - a. Academy of the Holy Names
 - b. Albany Academy (Girls' Campus)
 - c. Our Savior's Lutheran School
 - d. Practices will take place between 6pm and 10pm

Tournaments

- 1. SAVB teams will participate in both **USAV** and **AAU** tournaments.
- 2. "Local" tournaments are any events within an hour driving distance and do not require a hotel.
- 3. Travel tournaments generally require at least one night in a hotel, but some do not. Popular travel locations for SAVB are Western New York, Massachusetts, Connecticut, Pennsylvania, and Rhode Island.

All **Girls 18u – 15u** teams can expect:

- About 16 tournament days
- Mostly travel events
- 1 or 2 local events

Girls 14u teams can expect:

- About 12 tournament days
- At least half local events
- About 2-3 travel events

All **Girls 13u – 12u** teams can expect:

- About 10 tournament days
- Mostly local events
- 1-2 travel events

All **Boys 18u – 15u** teams can expect:

- About 15 tournament days
- Mostly travel events
- 1 or 2 local events

Boys 14u teams can expect:

- About 10 tournament days
- Mostly travel events
- 1 or 2 local events

Club Fees/Payments

What can you expect to pay?

1. USAV Membership.

- Attained through SportsEngine. Click HERE to sign in and/or create an account.
- All players are required to have an "XLRVA Junior Player" membership upon acceptance to a team. It should be around \$65-75. If you have previously purchased a cheaper membership for tryouts, you will be able to upgrade to the "Full" membership for the difference. Your receipt will show the membership split into separate costs for USAV and XLRVA, but the end total should be the same.

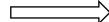
2. Sporting Albany Club Membership Fee

- Membership fees cover the costs of tournament fees, practice gym rentals, uniform costs, admin costs, and equipment costs.
- <u>Club membership fees will also cover each athletes' AAU membership. The club will</u> submit all AAU memberships so parents do not have to!
- Travel costs are NOT included in the club fees.
